the 14th Feb in Apr would be bety

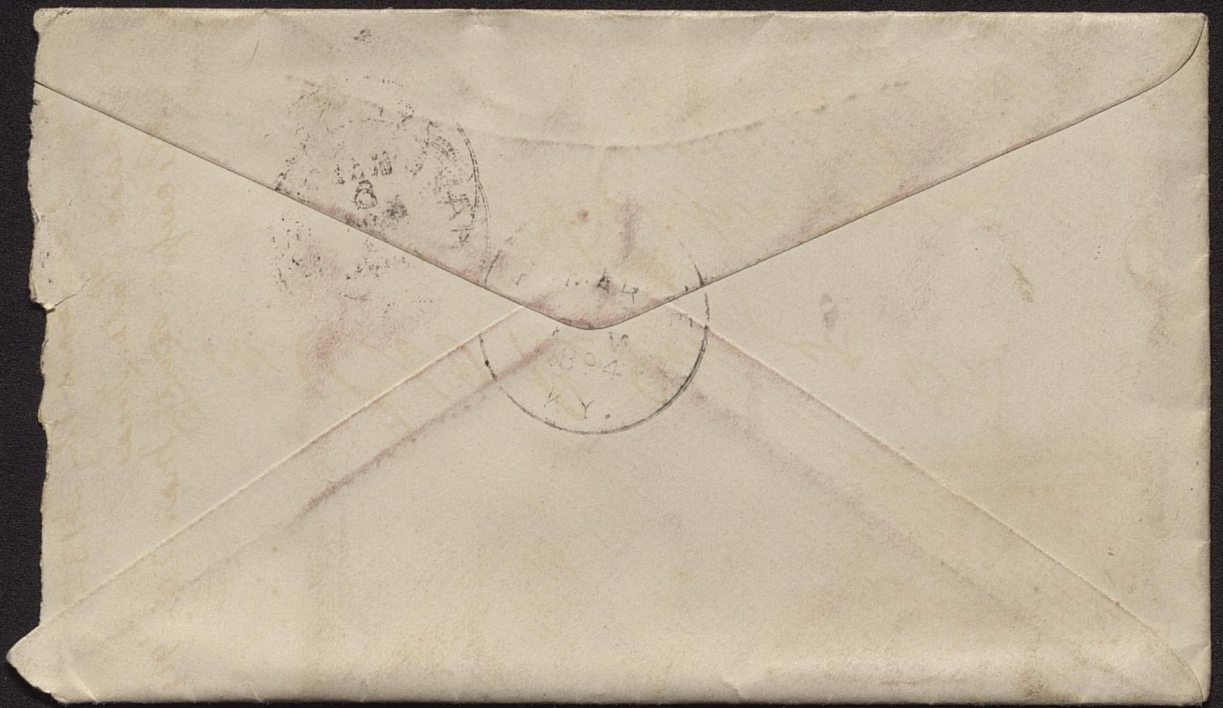
for good results. Nevertheless, the less if you
