

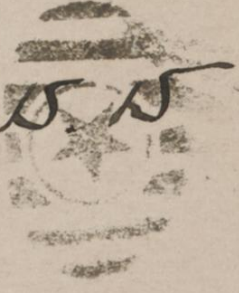

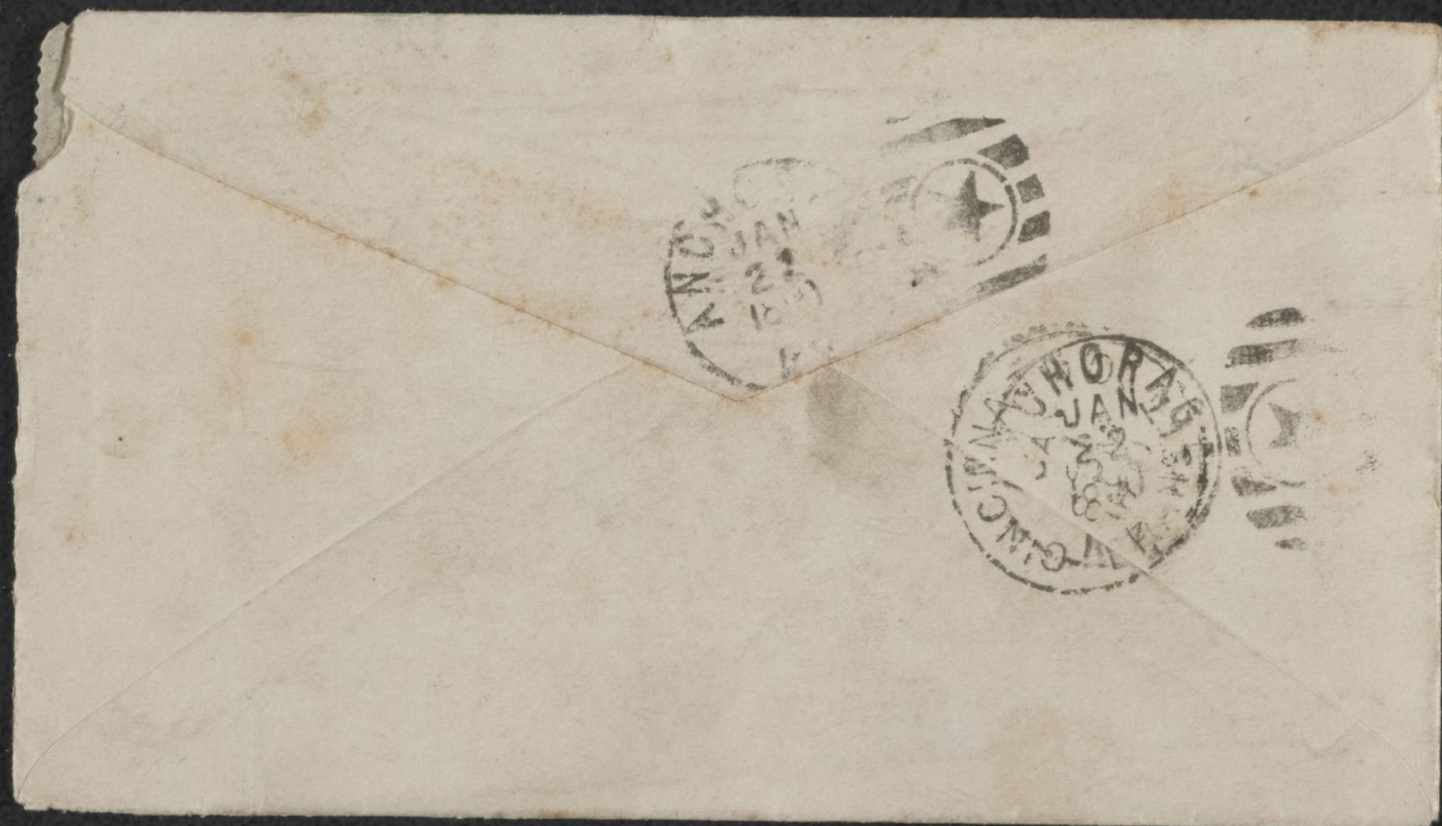

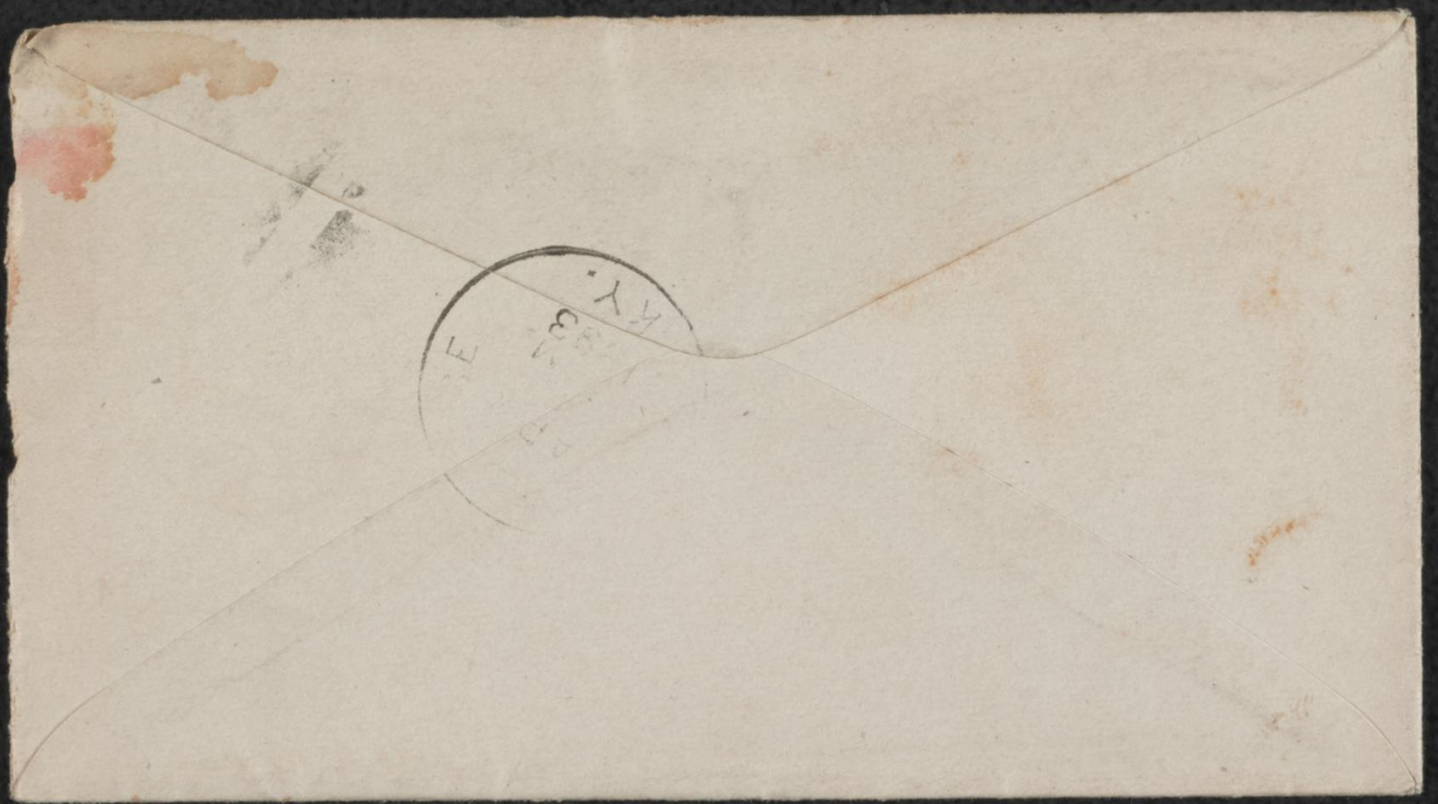

Dear Mr. Bedinger:

Enclosed please find check for thirty-two, (\$32.<sup>00</sup>) dollars, to be credited to Elizaville Church on Evangelistic work.

Unavoidable causes have delayed the collection, and I am sorry I cannot send more now, but will send you more as soon as possible.

I fear however, that I will not be able to raise the full appropriation of the Elizaville Church. Death has been very busy in taking off an unusual proportion of our best men and women. Forty members have died in a little over three years, representing much of the sub-

stance of that Church. This  
condition of things very much  
cripples the financial ability  
of that Church at least for  
the present. I hope the new gen-  
eration who must take up the  
work will prove equal to the  
Emergency.
