if they can, which I suppose  
they are trying to do.

I hope you may be enabled  
to visit them with Washing-  
ton & direct that they may  
pay for half of the time.

whom I hope to gather into  
the church. Pray God blessing  
upon my efforts there.

work is progressing favorably.  
May God add His blessing more  
& more upon you & all the

them?

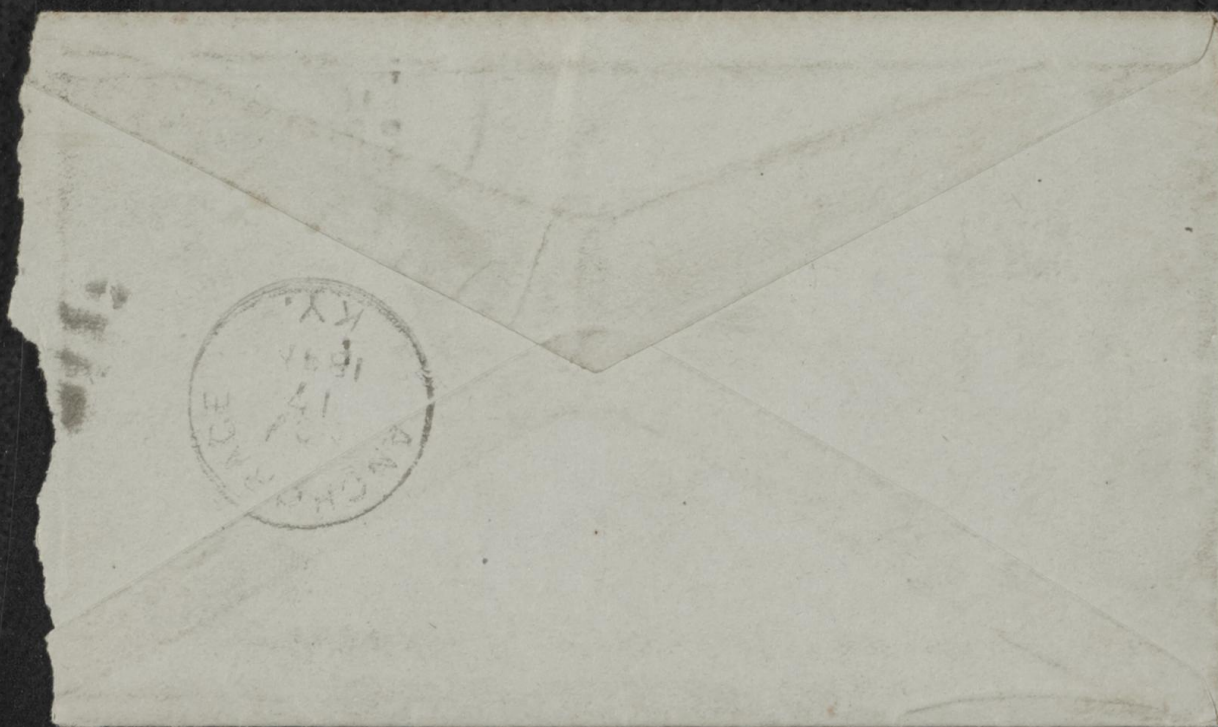
