

A. N. College March 5th 1886 171

Faculty met in called meeting at 12 M. in Pres^{ts} room. All present. The President explained the object of the meeting as follows: there had been established with the knowledge and sanction of the military com^{dr} Col. Phelps, a committee among the students in the dormitory for the better maintenance of cleanliness and order, such action having been voluntary on the part of the students. This self-constituted committee inflicted penalties for improprieties committed in the dormitory and grounds attached, these penalties being sanctioned by Col. Phelps. It was now proposed to place the interior discipline of the Dormitory and grounds entirely into the hands of the students, the Faculty retaining in every case ultimate jurisdiction. Prof. Crandall moves that so that end a Committee of three be appointed by the President to draw up instructions for such voluntary Board of Discipline. Seconded - carried. The President appointed Professors Crandall Kirby and Scoville. On motion Prof. White and Col. Phelps were added. Committee to report as soon as possible. - Cadet J. W. Manuery appeals from the decision of the Students Board of Discipline. His case having been heard, Faculty decides that he is to be confined to his quarters for one week. Moved and seconded to adjourn. Adjourned.
