

MIAMI — The U.S. Supreme Court vesterday relused to get involved in the case of Terri Schiavo, clearing the way for the husbard of the severely brain-damaged Florida woman to have been feeding tube unhooked by a state court order.

Barring an unlikely change of heart by Florida judges, Schiavo, now 41, could die soon in a nursing

Robert Schindler, Schiavo's
father, told reporters Monday,

The justices dismissed without comment Florida Gov Jeb Bush's claim that he had the power and responsibility to keep Schiavo alive after a state judge authorized removal of the tube through which she receives foot and water.

The governor was appealing a September decision by Florida's Supreme Court that found "Terri's Law" — a measure passed by the state Legislature that gave Bush the one-time power to order the tube reinstated — violate dethe separation of powers.

share at least one gigabyte of content.
That is all it takes to have access to over 100 terabytes — for those of you not technological inclination at the property of the content among file swappers at over 400 colleges and universities around the world.
Currently, i2hub must be run from a computer connected to the university network or ResNet. An extended i2hub is planned, and it would allow students living off campus to share in the benefits of the program.
The software is currently only available to users of Windows-based operating systems, but a Mac version is in the works.




