Come prepared to Memorial Coliseum Centralized ADD/DROP will be held Tuesday

It's once again time for the infamous ADD/DROP process to go into effect. And for many students, this will mean lines, disappointment and headaches.

But if the student follows some simple steps, Tuesday's centralized ADD/DROP process can go smoothly, considering the circumstances.

ADD/DROP is a process initiated by UK which allows dissatisfied students who advanced registration to "mend" their schedules which were sent to them during the summer. Although 97 percent of the course requests made during spring advance registration were honored, George Dexter, UK associate registrar, said students who were not satisfied with schedules and class times can change those at ADD/DROP.

Dexter noted, however, that students should realize the limitations imposed on ADD/DROP — such as single section openings and heavily requested courses — and consequently "remain fairly flexible, scheduling around classes which offer only single sections first and then (schedule classes) with multi-sections."

Although he had no estimates on

how many people would go through ADD/DROP Tuesday, Dexter said about 5,000 students have utilized the process in the past.

Dexter said the alternate course selections used during spring registration might help cut down the number who go through ADD/DROP, but said it's hard to say because he doesn't think "the alternate requests system is used to the best advantage by the students." He did say the 97 percent course requests honored during spring registration was up a little from the usual 96 percent figure.

Centralized ADD/DROP is scheduled to get underway at 10 a.m. Tuesday morning at Memorial Coliseum. Students should adhere strictly to the alphabetically (last name first) appointed times; the scheduled times are fixed to keep the process running smoothly.

Students may show up a few minutes early if they wish to be at the front of the line, but the doors won't open to students until their respective scheduled time.

Before you arrive at the Coliseum, you should:

- ✓ Check with your advisor to see what courses you need to take. If you don't know who your advisor is or don't have one, check with your department.

Look at the Supplement to the Fall Schedule of Classes listed in this edition and try to determine which courses you want and need to sign up for.

When you arrive at the Coliseum,

and an ADD/DROP slip. The permit card allows you to go through ADD/DROP and the ADD/DROP slip has seven spaces for adding and dropping classes.

After you decide which courses

Each class section you add and drop requires a computer card. For example, if you decide to add a section, then you must pick up a computer card for that section. And if you decide to drop a section, you must pick up a computer card for that section.

However, only one ADD/DROP slip is needed for all transactions.

The computer cards must be filled out with a No. 2 lead pencil. Students must write their social security number on these cards as well as what class is being added or dropped.

At ADD/DROP, you can also change the number of credit hours you get for variable credit courses as well as change the grading option to a letter grade, pass/fail or audit. If changing credit from a letter grade to pass/fail, you should be sure not to overextend the allowed three pass/fail options granted by the University.

After you have completed filling out all necessary transactions, then you must take your ADD/DROP slip and computer cards to the table of the dean of the college in which you are enrolled.

To alleviate mistakes when filling out the computer cards and ADD/DROP slips, Dexter said the student should read all directions and make sure the course listed on the computer cards and ADD/DROP

slips are the correct ones, with the right course and section number.

Dexter said students should also double check their social security numbers to ensure they have entered the right one.

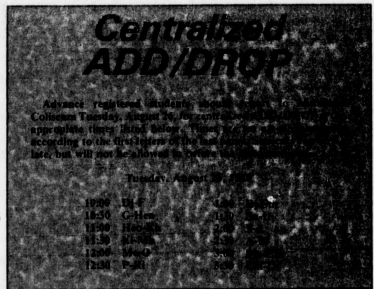
Students should remember to keep their ADD/DROP slips for possible verification in the future. Store it in a safe place such as your wallet, desk or file where it can be easily obtained. This way, if an error occurs, you can prove that you signed up for or dropped a course.

On Wednesday and Thursday, continuing students who did not register for the fall semester as well as new students who did not register Monday can do so at the Patterson Office Tower Mezzanine between 8:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

These students should get a course request form at the Mezzanine and then pick up an IBM class ticket for each desired course at the respective department where the course is offered.

After getting all the class tickets for each course, students should then fill out the course request form with approval of the dean of their respective college. The cards and the course request form are then turned in at the Mezzanine.

Students who are late registering must pay a \$20 fee.



you should:

- ✓ Have proper identification, either a driver's license or UKID.
- ✓ Pick up the instruction sheet informing you of where to go and what to do.
- ✓ Pick up an IBM permit card

A little easier

Here's a list of some helpful facts to ease the transition back into college life

Amidst all the hustle and bustle of getting back into the college life, something important might be forgotten which later may prove detrimental. So here're a few reminders and hints to help get into the swing of things hassle-free.

Tuition payments that have not previously been made by mail, can be taken care of in the Student Center Ballroom from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, Aug. 25, through Friday, Aug. 29. After Aug. 29, payment of registration fees can be made in the Billings and Collections office, 220 Service Building, between 8 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.

The deadline is 3:30 p.m., Sept. 10, after which a student's fall registration will then be canceled.

A student may be reinstated from Sept. 11 through Sept. 19, 1980, upon payment of total registration fees in addition to a \$50 reinstatement fee.

A student wishing to withdraw from the University and receive a refund must do so before this Wednesday, Aug. 27.

Between Aug. 27 and Sept. 3, a student is entitled to receive a refund of 80 percent of the registration fee paid if he or she withdraws from the University.

Withdrawal after Sept. 3 and prior

to Oct. 17 warrants the student a refund of 50 percent of the registration fee paid. No refunds will be made to students who officially withdraw after Oct. 17.

Student ID cards can be validated when a student makes the registration fee payment in the Ballroom this week. If registration fees were paid by mail but the ID card was not validated, then a student may also have it validated this week.

After Aug. 29, ID validation will be taken care of in Room 220, Service Building.

New students can have their free ID cards made in the Student Center Ballroom Monday through Friday. New students must have ID cards made before Sept. 10, after which there will be a \$5 late fee.

After Aug. 29, student IDs will be made and distributed in the UK Photographic Services offices: Room 0005, Kastle Hall on Mondays, 1:15 p.m. to 4:15 p.m. and Thursdays, 8:15 a.m. to 11:45 a.m.

A student will be charged \$5 for the replacement of a lost ID. John Mitchell, manager of the photographic services, said students should have some proof of identification — preferably a Kentucky driver's license with a picture on it. If not, then two other forms of identification would be acceptable.

If a student loses a meal card it can be replaced at the Food Storage office located on Donovan Drive behind K-Laite grill. The office is open weekdays from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

A temporary card will be issued while the permanent card is being developed.

A \$5 fee will be charged for a first-time card replacement, and there will be a \$10 charge for the second time it is lost.

Food Services will have tables set up in the Student Center Ballroom this week during the fee payment

period from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for remaining meal card payments.

Students can pay the \$21 Student Health Fee in the Student Center Ballroom this week. A Health Service information table will be located at the foot of the Ballroom stairs. The Health Fee can be paid only by check and must be paid before the 3:30 p.m., Sept. 19 deadline in order to be valid for the fall semester.

After Aug. 29, the Health Fee can be paid at Billings and Collections, 220 Service Building.

"In a time when no one has any money, \$21 for a semester is an awfully cheap way of getting health care," said Jean Cox, administrator of the Student Health Service.

"Students have the security of knowing that if they pre-pay the health fee they will not have a lot of out-of-the-pocket expense," she added.

The \$21 fall semester Student Health Fee is in effect from Aug. 25, 1980, through Jan. 11, 1981. All full-time and part-time Lexington campus students, including

Lexington Technical Institute students, are eligible.

"An incentive might be that students need to stay healthy to do well in school," Cox said. If a student has not paid the Health Fee and becomes sick during the semester, Cox said he or she might end up paying a \$35 or \$40 bill for one visit.

A Blue Cross/Blue Shield insurance plan is also available for students. It will cover charges such as hospitalization, surgical procedures or accident care that are not included

Financial aid checks will be authorized by officials in Student Center Ballroom

Financial aid checks will be dispersed to recipients this week from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. daily in the Grand Ballroom. The time and place is the same this year — the method is different.

The Financial Aid Office will have people available to authorize the financial aid checks. However, financial aid checks will be dispersed by Billings and Collections.

An authorization slip will be given to the student which in turn must be

given to Billings and Collections cashiers who will be stationed between financial aid tables.

Students who have not yet been notified about whether they will receive financial aid, those who applied late and those who plan to apply, should wait to check with the Financial Aid office until the last of September or the first of October, said Jim Ingle, director of the student financial aid office.

"It will be at least that long before their applications will be processed," he said. The office is still accepting

applications and will continue to do so as long as funds are available, Ingle added.

"During the first week of school no applications will be evaluated," he said, adding that evaluations will be resumed by the end of September. "After school starts we will no longer be sending out notifications (to financial aid recipients). Students must come into the office."

If checks are not picked up this week, students must first go to the Financial Aid Office for authorization procedures and then

to Billings and Collections, Room 220 Service Building, to receive the financial aid checks.

Ingle said that in the past the financial aid lines have been longer on Monday and Tuesday but tended to deteriorate by the end of the week. Students usually do not have quite as long a wait then, he added.

Students who have been hired for the work-study program should go to the fifth floor of the Patterson Office Tower to receive their job assignments.

Important dates to remember for the fall semester

Aug. 25 — Registration for new students who have not advanced registered. Ballroom open for fee payments, ID pictures and validation between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. through Friday, August 29.

Aug. 26 — Centralized ADD DROP for Advanced Registered Students. Last day a student may officially drop a course or cancel registration with the registrar for a full refund of fees. "C-1" parking permits issued at the Student Center on a first-come basis from 9 a.m. to noon and "C-2" from 1:30 to 4 p.m.

Aug. 27 — Classes begin. "R" and remaining "C-2" parking stickers issued at

Student Center through Aug. 28 from 8:30 a.m. to noon and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Aug. 27 - Sept. 3 — Late registration for returning students who did not advance register and new applicants cleared late for admission. A \$20 fee is assessed students who register late.

Sept. 3 — Last day to enter an organized class for the fall semester. Last day to officially withdraw from the University and receive an 80 percent refund.

Sept. 10 — Last day for payment of registration fees in order to avoid cancellation of registration. Last day for new

students to pick up ID cards from Photographic Services in order to avoid replacement fee.

Sept. 17 — Last day to change grading option (pass fail to letter grade or letter grade to pass fail; credit to audit or audit to credit). Last day to drop a course without it appearing on the student's transcript.

Sept. 19 — Last day for reinstatement of students cancelled for non-payment of registration fees. Requires payment of registration fees plus \$50 reinstatement fee. Last day to pay Student Health Fee valid for fall semester.

Sept. 25 — Last day for filing an application for a December degree in College Dean's office.

Sept. 30 — Last day to

enroll in UK Student Blue Cross and Blue Shield plan.

Oct. 17 — Last day to drop a course. Last day to withdraw from the University or reduce

course schedule and receive any refund.

Nov. 10-19 — Advance registration for the 1981

Spring Semester.

Dec. 12 — End of class work.

Dec. 15-19 Final examinations.

in the Student Health Fee coverage.

With the Blue Cross Blue Shield plan students will receive an "increase in benefits at a decrease in cost," Cox said. "The plan can be purchased at a rate lower than last fall," she added.

The open enrollment period

for the UK Student Blue Cross and Blue Shield Plan is Aug. 25 through Sept. 30, 1980. An information table will be set up in the Ballroom this week.

Cox urges students to take care of the Health Fee and insurance plan payments during the first week of school while information areas are

placed in the Student Center. Parking permits will be issued beginning Tuesday at the Student Center. They will be issued to full-time junior, senior and graduate students on a first-come basis.

"C-1" permits will be issued Tuesday from 9 a.m. to noon and "C-2" stickers from 1:30

p.m. to 4 p.m. "R" permits and remaining "C-2" permits will be issued on Wednesday and Thursday, 8:30 a.m. to noon and 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Remaining "R" Parking permits will also be issued Friday, 8:30 a.m. to noon and 1 p.m. to 2:45 p.m.

The University Book Store will allow a full return on any text purchased in the store up to the last day for drop-add each semester. The last day for a full refund for fall semester will be September 5th. After this date there is a one day return policy.

If a new book is returned for a refund or exchange, it must be in new condition. Autographed copies or copies with underlining that cannot be returned to the publisher as new books will not be accepted for a full refund exchange.

Books purchased during the summer for use in the fall may be returned or exchanged for other texts if you find it necessary to change a course or section, provided you have your sales slip, and the refund or exchange is by the last day for drop-add.

BUY BACK POLICY

When selling your books at the end of the semester, keep in mind that:

- 50 per cent of the list will be paid for the current editions of textbooks for which we have received orders from the departments for the coming semesters. (Except for books on which we are overstocked.)
- Up to 30 per cent of the list price for current editions for which we have no order or current edition which have been discontinued. This will depend on the current wholesale price.
- Up to 25 per cent for paperback books which are not considered textbooks by the publishers.

No refunds will be made without a sales receipt. It is necessary and a good record of your purchases.
