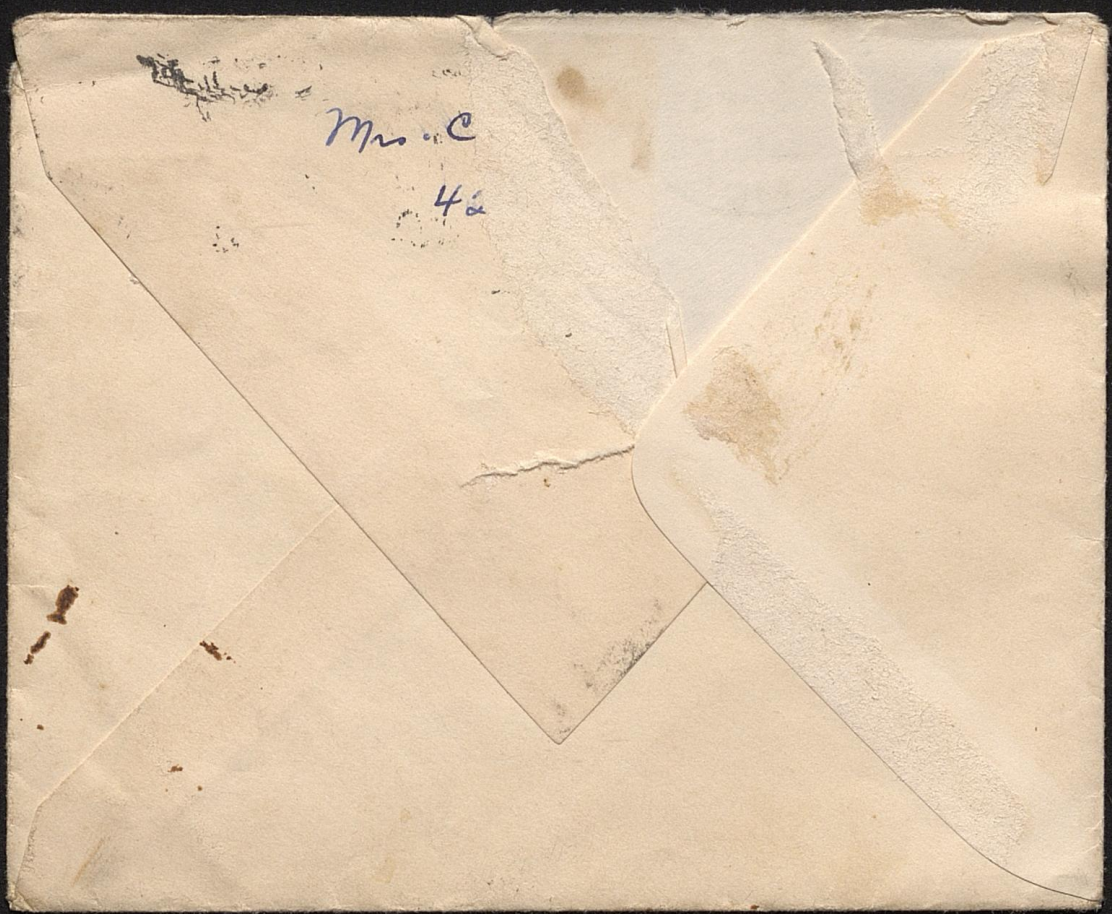

Pops cold is a little better. Think we will have to pay around 4000

about you. Jim you said you were sorry about things. Well just
try & not do it again & then see know you are sorry. If you
don't you are really going to be sorry for my health won't take

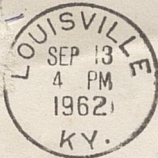

Inclosed you money ^{7.500} for
next 2 weeks. I may not get
up. Sharon still is sick - may
have to get the co. yet, as
she is getting day - so I'll do my
best for her. Don't mention the
money I sent. May not have
any more until 25th or 1st
as spending on Sharon. Pop may
come up then. I'll write in
few days & let you know how Sherry
is. She's already better but weak.
Sat. We went to hospital ~~Spish~~
& they said she could do without
the co. & that they couldn't keep her
any more & I should get her in Gen ^{hospital}
Clinic & see Dr. Rosman brain specialist

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So I may take her next week
but I will not have all those
tests made over as just got them
at St Joe's. Her medicine & Dr. Bill
this week was \$26.00 so we
have to quit some where. What
good does test do if they do
nothing for her. Got some
suppositories & phenobarb at St Joe's
just \$11.75. they must think Retired
Man is rich. Pop signed
lease for Cindrella today & pd
\$150.00 down. \$28.00 mo. for 2 years
but hasn't heard anything from
both shops that I told you
about before. so perhaps will soon.
I sure hope you've made up your
mind to live right regardless what
comes or goes. For all this is
sacrifice to us & we can't stand

3 much more worry or hardships.
Sharon's been too weak to walk
this week but stronger today. We
have to hold her & lead her
trusting she will get over this in few
days as vomiting stopped - Well the
mail man came & I rec. your letter
I can see lots of your points but
that's to be later. I was grieved
enough with ~~out~~ those harsh words,
or should I say thoughtless ones, well
I'll close as Sharon is crowing
to me & I have to quit & take her
since I'm occupied with Sharon I'm
not worried when pop is coming up
if he doesn't get up soon I'll get
him to mail you some tobacco. So
be write if I get to city hospital &
tell you what they say -
