Prof. Mackenzie discussed the deficiencies of our students in English and protested against the custom of permitting students to graduate without ever being given any test in his dept. of their qualifications in English.

Prof. James White read a letter from Mrs. Stout in which she expressed the wish that, on account of a letter of regret and apology received by her from the young ladies concerned - the restrictions <sup>upon the</sup> of social and athletic privileges <sup>upon</sup> the young ladies of the basket ball team, decided upon at the meeting of March 29, be removed.

Prof. White seconded by Prof. Neville moved that the request of Mrs. Stout be granted.

Faig seconded the motion and upon roll call both the amendment and the original motion as amended were unanimously carried. Professors W. K. Patterson, Faig and Mathews were excused from voting.
