
In connection with the approval of these degrees, President Donovan mentioned to the Faculty that it may be necessary to resume the practice of having a summer school commencement, since several students and parents have expressed dissatisfaction with the present procedure.

On recommendation of Assistant Dean Horlacher, the petition of Thomas Bradley Christie was approved. Mr. Christie asked that he be permitted to do 18 quarter hours of work away from the University. The maximum amount allowed under the rules is 9 quarter hours. It was pointed out that Mr. Christie had done all of his other work in residence at the University of Kentucky and that he is now an officer in the U.S. Army.

Professor B. A. Shively, Director of Athletics and Coach Adolph Rupp appeared before the Faculty and again reviewed the problem involved in the recruitment of candidates for University athletic teams. They asked in particular that exceptions be made to the rules governing admissions in the case of the following four men, and that they be admitted to the University for the fall quarter:

Jack Parkinson
Bob Brannum
Victor Jadrnak

On motion, duly made and seconded, the Faculty voted that these four men be admitted to the University and that a special committee be appointed to study these and related problems of admissions and report back to the Faculty. The President appointed to this committee, Leo M. Chamberlain, L. J. Horlacher, and William S. Taylor. The next meeting of the Faculty was scheduled for 3 p.m. Friday, September 24.
