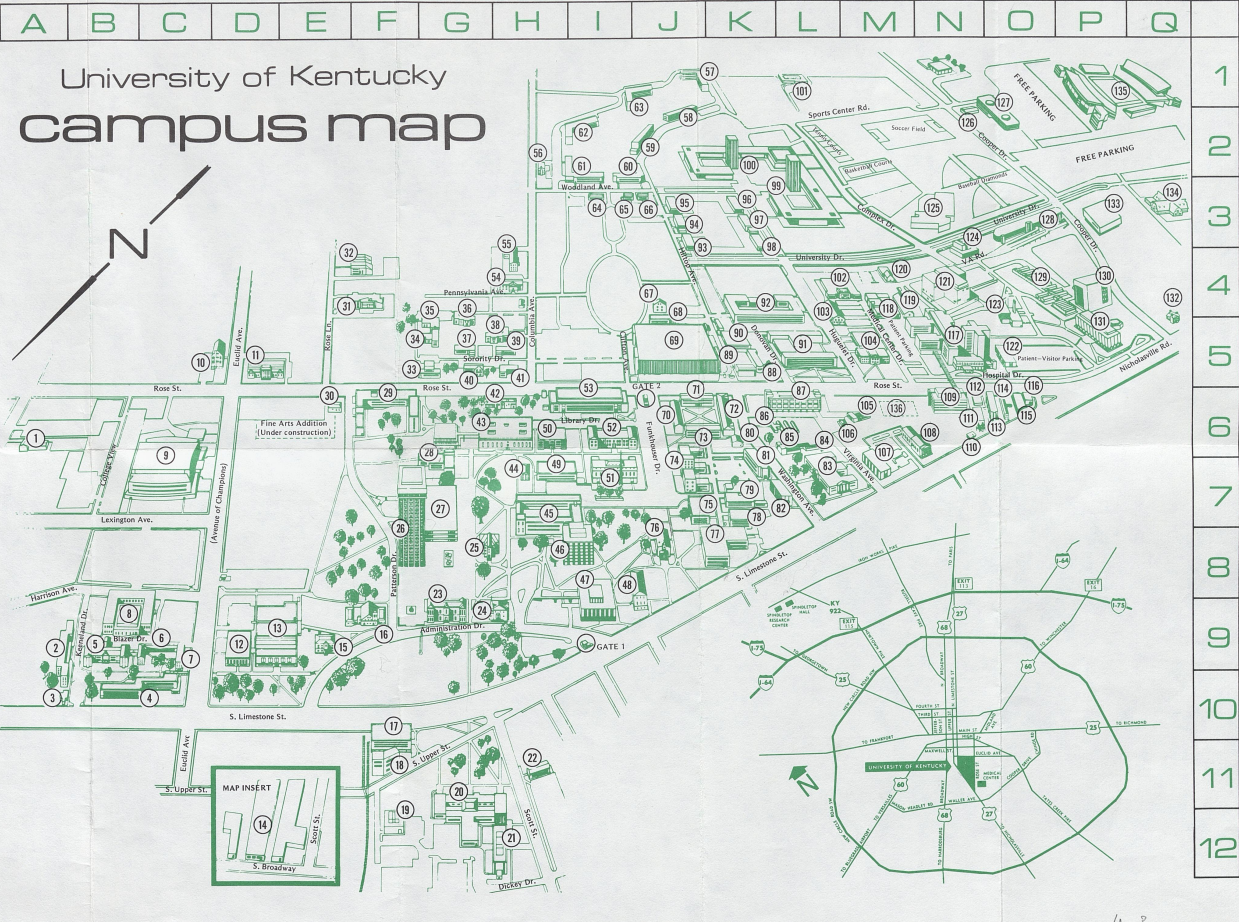


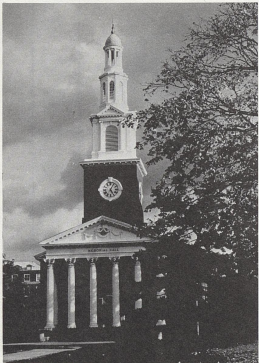

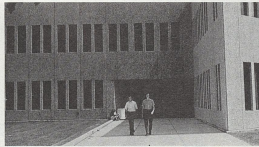

MEMORIAL HALL—More than any other building, Memorial Hall symbolizes the University to the UK alumnus. Originally intended as a chapel in memory of Kentucky's sons who died in World War I, the building now is used primarily for concerts, lectures, and some classes. Its outdoor amphitheatre is used during spring, summer and fall months for classes and student activities.



DON CASH SEATON SPORTS CENTER—A geometrically-designed building erected in the early 1970's—one of the most unique structures of its kind in the nation—features a large, versatile gym that accommodates several team sports simultaneously, handball courts, physical fitness rooms, research labs, offices and classrooms. With bright, attractive decor, and well-equipped with body-building devices, the center is one of the most-used buildings on campus.



BLANDING-KIRWAN RESIDENTIAL COMPLEX—A 23-story \$22 million housing project on a 25.5-acre site, accommodating 2,664 students in two 240-foot towers and eight low rise dorms. Units are comfortably furnished for student living with carpeting, central air, tv lounges and snack bars. Observation lounges at the top give an impressive view of the campus, Commonwealth Stadium and Lexington.



PATTERSON OFFICE TOWER—The 19-story tower houses more than 1,000 faculty members, primarily in Arts and Sciences, Library Science, Social Professions, Student Affairs, and the Patterson School of Diplomacy. The top floor has well-appointed meeting and conference rooms, lounges, and an observation area. The **WHITE HALL CLASSROOM BUILDING**—adjoining the Patterson Tower with both underground and above ground walkways, features large modern classrooms which accommodate nearly 4,000 students. It is one of the largest structures of its kind in the nation.



STUDENT CENTER—This low level building with bookstore is one of the most popular spots on campus with lounges, meeting rooms, game rooms, cafeteria and grill, dance floor, cinema and art gallery.

WELCOME TO THE UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY



Since you're using this map, you're probably a new student or a visitor to the University. If you possibly have time, be sure to take a tour aboard "Old Blue." The old double-deck English bus, donated to UK by the Alumni Association, leaves from in front of the Student Center Monday through Friday at 2 p.m., and makes the rounds of the campus community. Usually a student tour guide is on hand to give added color to college life, and to explain the many facets of the University and its 20,000-student body.

During your tour, you'll view more than 100 major buildings, some old history-laden structures with completely renovated interiors, and some just completed, housing ultra modern teaching and research facilities and equipment. You might keep in mind that in addition to the Lexington Technical Institute the University also includes a dozen community colleges strategically located across the state, bringing college close to home for nearly 17,000 off-campus UK students.

The University at Lexington is broken down into 17 academic colleges—a large number of institutes, bureaus, supportive and administrative offices—and the Albert B. Chandler Medical Center. It is one of the leading research centers in the nation, and has become widely recognized for its outstanding contributions to the improvement of human health.
