On motion the resolution was unanimously approved, and ordered to be entered upon the records of the Board, and published in the daily papers.

On motion of Gen. Hobson ordered that the annual report of the President to the Board of Trustees be published for distribution to the citizens of the Commonwealth.

It is understood that the report may be revised by the President, that at least one thousand copies shall be printed, at a reasonable cost (say ten dollars)

During the morning session of the Board Hon. James Wilson Secretary of Agriculture in the cabinet of Mr. McKinley was introduced to the body and remained during the remainder of the sitting. Courtesus greetings were exchanged and the Secretary expressed his gratification in seeing evidences of so much good work done by the college.

On motion the Board adjourned to meet on December 12th, 1899.
