6. "Life members" and "Honorary members" are not recognized.
7. Lodges U. D. are governed by the same rules as chartered lodges, except they do not elect officers and need not have a seal.

PENALTY

The penalty for failure to make return by September and pay dues not later than Sept. 28 is a \$5 fine, which must be paid or charter is forfeited. (See Constitution, Sections 14, 149, 155, and Proceedings, 1911, page 84; 1915, page 158.)





If a minister, put "Rev." after his name; if a Master Mason affiliated for fifty years, put "fifty years" after his name, and in margin give name and number of Lodge in which he was made a Master Mason, and if in an asylum, put "in asylum" after his name.
6. "Life members" and "Honorary members" are not recognized.
7. Lodges U. D. are governed by the same rules as chartered lodges, except they do not elect officers and need not have a seal.

PENALTY

The penalty for failure to make return by September 3 and pay dues not later than Sept. 28 is a \$5 fine, which must be paid or charter is forfeited. (See Constitution)

Answer questions about return *promptly*, or errors will appear in printed proceedings. The printer can not wait, and it will save you "lots" of trouble.
