## IN MAKING RETURNS OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING

## RULES:

1. Follow instructions at the top of each page.
2. Remember the military report at *dress parade*: "ALL present or accounted for." So *all* who were reported as members last year must be "present" members, "or accounted for" as dead, demitted, suspended, or expelled. All who are now members are "accounted for" as having been members per last return, or who have since become members by initiation, admission, or reinstatement.
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5. Ministers who derive their support from preaching, and members who have been affiliated Master Masons of Kentucky Lodges for fifty years, are exempt from payment of dues to Grand Lodge \$1.00, but pay the Home assessments and Journal \$1.75. Members confined in insane asylum are exempt from payment of Grand Lodge dues and Home assessments. If a minister, put "Rev." after his name; if a Master Mason affiliated for fifty years, put "fifty years" after his name, and in margin give name and number of Lodge in which he was made a Master Mason, and if in an asylum, put "in asylum" after his name.
6. "Life members" and "Honorary members" are not recognized.
7. Lodges U. D. are governed by the same rules as chartered lodges, except they do not elect officers and need not have a seal.

## PENALTY

 The penalty for failure to make return by September 3 and pay dues not later than Sept. 28 is a \$5 fine, which must be paid or charter is forfeited. (See Constitution)

Answer questions about return *promptly*, or errors will appear in printed proceedings. The printer can not wait, and it will save you "lots" of trouble.




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
