My Dear Wife,

Your welcome letter of the 3rd postmarked the 6th June was received this day viz 1 hour since, and found me ready or thereabouts for my dinner, which was Ed Shelby ham Bryant Peaches Jersey wheat bread ~~Yoshua Butter~~ & tolerably good water, but the latter not near so good as ours in the cooler.
