

Sacramento City Sept 8th 1850
Dear father

It painfull necessity ^{prompted} me to write to you, it is to inform you that the remains of the lamented Henry Duralde were yesterday recovered. ~~they~~ his body was found 3 miles above this place floating among the bushes. He was brought to this place, where an inquest was held over it. A verdict was returned in accordance with the facts already known to you last night Mr Mc Neir & myself went th^r to see the body we found it so much disfigured as to be unable to recognise the features but his clothing & the articles found on him told too truly that the disfigured & revolting ~~corpses~~ was all that remained of the gallant the gay & talented Duralde. On his body was found about 28\$ in gold coin, a breast pin & several other small articles his journal was also found. Mr Mc Neir promptly & generously ~~paid~~
