B. 341), by Young Denton (963), g. g. gr. dam Prize, by Young Denton (963), g. g. g. gr. dam Buckhorn. Selima was bred by Hon. C. A. Barritz, by Emperor, dam Kate; both pedigrees are given in Powell's Catalogues. Io was by Alonzo; Alonzo was bred by Hon. C. A. Barritz, by Hyman, dam Portia, by imp. Malcolm (1190), gr. dam Delight, imp. by Col. Powell, in 1826, and in Herd Book for 1829. J. M. CLAY.
