The Faculty convened at the call of the President, Mr. R. M. Roark having requested a meeting to consider an hour for the Teachers' Training class in the Normal Department.

Hence arose the necessity of putting it at some hour when it would not come in conflict with any other class.

After some discussion, a motion offered by Mr. Miller was carried, putting into effect the suggestions of the President, - that the Teachers' Training class should meet at 7:30 a.m., the military formation occur at 8:20 a.m., and that students go directly from chapel to the class-rooms, for the first hour classes, without forming for section marching.
