Voted on motion of Prof Kastle seconded by Prof Anderson that College duties be suspended on the 14th of April 1899.

Ordered on motion of Prof. Mathews that a committee, of which President Patterson shall be chairman, be appointed to arrange a programme for appropriate ceremonies on the 14th of April.
Prof Mathews and Prof Anderson were appointed to act with the President.

The Deans of the Courses of study were appointed to determine the class honors.

Prof. Kastle, Brooks, and Anderson were appointed a committee to prepare a programme for commencement exercises.

On motion of Prof. Anderson ordered that the Classification of students for the Catalogue list be made, by the Deans of the respective courses, in accordance with the order of the Board relative thereto and submitted to the Committee on Catalogue by 8.30 am March 20, 99.
