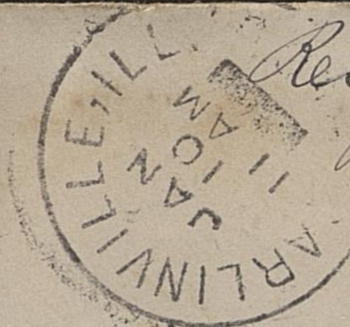

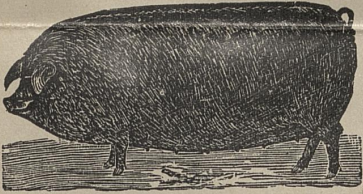

Sir:

Referring to your letter of the 31st ultimo, you are advised that as Wilburton, I. T., is some distance south of the Texas fever quarantine line and in the tick-infested area, you would incur quite a risk in taking cows from Illinois to that part of the country unless you are sure arrangements can be made to keep such cows in a tick-free pasture or inclosure of some kind where they would not come in contact with the Texas fever tick (*Boophilus annulatus*). Farmers' Bulletin No. 258 bearing on this subject is mailed you under separate cover.
