

W. M. College of Ky. Jan 10-1908.

The faculty met at 3.30 P. M. all present except professors Anderson, Mathews, Howwood, M. White, Frankel and Corbuer.

Prof. Anderson submitted the name of E. A. Cline as a candidate for graduation ^{as M. E.}

The name of Miss Nancy A. Buford was entered as a candidate for the degree of ^{A. M.} in 1900, work to be assigned by Dr. Neville, and Prof. Mackenzie.

A letter was read from Misses Wandless and Boyd in which they state that Prof. Jones admitted them to full Junior standing in the Classical Course in Sept-1906, from the Louisville Girls High School. Later, learning that their credits for advanced standing had not been recorded in the college records they asked that such record be made, inasmuch as the said credits had been given verbally by Prof. Jones, but that Dr. Puette objected to this.

They ask that the faculty decide the question as to their just deserts in the case.

on motion of Prof. Anderson, it was ordered that the request of Misses Boyd and Wandless be referred to Dr. Puette.

The meeting adjourned.
