Lexington, Feb. 16, 1894.

The Faculty convened, pursuant to adjournment, at 12:30 p.m., to take action upon the request of the Literary Societies to be allowed to take part in the Intercollegiate Oratorical Contests. There was a full discussion, closed by the adoption of a motion, by Prof. J. W. Nelson, amended by Prof. Kastle, to appoint a Committee, consisting of Messrs. Blackford, Neville, Nelson, Anderson, White, and Roark, which should have full power to settle the whole matter of our representation in the Oratorical Contests. It was ordered, also, that this Committee should consider some means of furnishing more training in expression, oral and written. Upon motion of Prof. J. W. Nelson the following were appointed a Committee to review the subject of a College paper - at present called the Cadet: - Messrs. Roark, Kastle, Mathews. It was further ordered that this Committee should, if it thought best, appoint the editor of the paper for the following year.
