The Scientific faculty met in the Natural Science Building, Pres. Patterson, Profs. White, Pryor, Kastle, Wernicke, Pence, Miller and Mathews.

The minutes of the October meeting and the November meeting were read and approved. The standing of individual students of this course was canvassed and after a discussion

of the work of Mr. Albert Loewenhart, it was moved by Prof. Wernicke seconded by Prof. Miller that this faculty shall ask Pres. Patterson to notify parents of Mr. Loewenhart that his work is in the main unsatisfactory. Carried.

The application of Mr. M. B. Jones for consideration as a candidate for the degree of M. S. he having taken A. B. as his bachelors degree, was presented.

It was moved by C. W. Mathews, seconded by Prof. Kastle that M. B. Jones shall be recommended to the general faculty as a candidate for the degree of M. S. with mathematics as his major subject and with the assignment of two minor scientific subjects. Carried.

The case of Mr. Jones' led to considerable discussion as to whether a student who has taken the degree of B. S. or B. A. at this college or other institution of learning of like standing may be allowed to become a candidate for either of the second degrees in Science or in the classics, and the opinion seemed to be

unanimous that no one should be received
Advanced as a candidate for such second degree until

On motion of Prof. Pence, seconded by
Prof. Miller the question as to these several
degrees was referred to the general faculty
with the recommendation that that Faculty
appoint a committee to consider the
matter and report thereon. Carried.
