This means that many traditional programs will have to be operated in such a way as to enhance the overall objective. We do not have any money to put into this program. By cutting deeply into already cut programs, we could have budgeted more and hurt present programs. However, we do have resources, our total staff.

Considering the pressures of on-going departmental objectives, each of us must participate on a task force charged with the responsibility of implementing the program. It must be fully understood that this is not an option, it is a requirement. It is not one where we can delegate the final responsibility to a surrogate. Once an assignment is made, accountability will be expected.

Due to the difficulty of distance a Coordinator must be named from the New York Office to manage day by day logistics. Due to staffing, New York will be the headquarters with frequent visits by the Detroit team. Our legal and legislative units must play an indispensable role. A communications center must be set up as a clearing-house.

I am asking each of you to bring any pertinent data in your possession related to reapportionment, redistricting, voting analysis and projections, demographics on target groups (minorities), and effort of other groups with similar missions.

Networking must be the key. Be prepared to tell us how and with whom.
