Wife Mary Ogden, daughter of old John Ogden, the
most notable manⁱⁿ Elizabeth founders.

John^{2^d} was the oldest son of John^{1st} and was one of
the founders of Elizabeth N.J. He held several offices
under the Colonial Government.




Tracing of MAJ. RICHARD EWEN, one of the first to settle on Patapsco River, Anne Arundel County, Maryland. Born England - to Maryland 1649.

1st generation in America:

* Maj. RICHARD EWEN died 1665. One of the first who took up land on the Patapsco River, Anne Arundel Co., Maryland. Owned 900 acres in 1652, called "Scotland" on Bay Shore, a little above Severn River. Member of Council of Maryland; Speaker of Assembly of 1657, which was called by the Puritans at Patuxent; one of the High Commissioners to govern Maryland under Lord Protector Cromwell; also, Major in the forces of the Colony. In 1657 Richard Ewen was Judge of Provincial Court; 1658 was named as a member of the 1st board of Commissioners of Anne Arundel Co., but declined the honor. Member House of Burgesses 1659-60; Capt. 1655; Major 1658; Commissioner of Anne Arundel Co., 1664; April 13, 1664-65, was appointed by Gov. Calvert, High Sheriff. He married Sophia -----

ELIZABETH EWEN, married 1656, RICHARD TALBOTT (died 1666) who came from England to Maryland about 1652; settled on "Poplar Knowle" plantation on West River, Anne Arundel Co., Md., 1656. "Talbot's Ridge" 300 acres in A.A.Co. were surveyed for him Nov. 30, 1662.
