To the Sheriff of *Mason* County, Greeting:

WE command you that of the estate of *Joseph Eubank and John Robertson* late of your bailiwick, you cause to be made the sum of *Sixty-one Dollars*

which they owe to *Charles Ward, admr of the Estate of William Bronaugh, decd* on a replevy bond, executed by the said

Robertson on the *3^d* day of *November* 1817, also the sum of *Thirty-three cents* which to the said *Charles Ward,*

adm. fr was adjudged for *his* costs by *him* herein expended, whereof the said *Joseph Eubank and John Robertson* are convict, as appears to us from the said replevy bond, filed in the clerk's office of the Mason circuit court. And that you have the said debt and costs, before our Judge of our said Mason circuit court, at the courthouse thereof, in the town of Washington, on the *third wednesday* in *April* next, to render to the said *Charles Ward, adm. fr*

the debt and costs aforesaid. And have then and there this writ. Witness, MARSHALL KEY, clerk of our said court, at the courthouse aforesaid, the *7th* day of *February* 1818, and in the *16th* year of our commonwealth.
