State College of Ky. Sept. 13, 1893.
 Faculty met in call session
 in the President's room. Present
 Presidents Patterson, Prof. Nelson, Roark,
 Pryor, Kaste, Miller, Helveti, Garman,
 Clay, Shackelford, Blanton, Nevill,

The President called the attention
 of the faculty to the action of
 the Board of Trustees concerning
 athletics. Prof. Nelson moved a
 committee of three be appointed
 to act with the President and
 to constitute an Athletic Committee
 from the faculty; this committee
 to have in charge all matters per-
 taining to athletics. The motion
 carried and Nelson, Miller and Blan-
 ton were appointed.

XX The committees on Course of Study
 and Pay-Laws for the government
 of the Faculty were each granted
 further time in which to make
 their reports.

After discussing minor matters
 the Faculty adjourned.

 Faculty met in the President's room.
 Present. Pres. Patterson, Prof. Shackelford,
 Blanton, Matthews, Helveti, White, Kaste,
 Pryor, Davis, Nelson, Roark, Nevill,
 Anderson, Bennett, Patterson and Newman.
 The President read the petitions of Bush
 and Ward, who were suspended the
 2nd of June 1893 for firing and breaking

one of the cannon. On motion they were reinstated, provided each paid his proportional part of the costs in repairing the damage to the cannon, as referred to above.
