Voted on motion of Prof. Anderson that it
is the sense of the faculty that any member
of the student body, in good standing, may
participate in the primary contests for the
honor of representing the College in the
annual oratorical contest at Chautauqua
grounds.

Voted on motion of Prof. Mathews that
any student of the College, who is not a
member of a Literary Society, shall be allowed
to participate in primary oratorical contests
on condition that he pay his proportion
of the expenses.

Adjourned to meet May 31, at 8 am.
