ARTICLE IX.	
TEACHERS. I. No person shall be deemed qualified to teach any common school herein provided for, unless such person shall first have obtained a cer-	
tificate of qualification to teach the subjects embraced in the common-scalooi course, signed by two members of the country board of examiners,	
class, and third-class. No certificate, except first-class, snain be issued to the same person indeed the third class certificate and person in the year from their date. A first-class certificate	
shall be valid for four years from its date, and may be continued four years longer by the county superintendent indorsing thereon "renewed," and subscribing his name, for which no fee shall be charged. But no certificate shall be valid out of the county in which it is granted. The	
State Board of Education shall define the qualification necessary in order to procure a certificate of each class.
