female negro slave named Rebecca
of black color and aged about 39
years. I warrant the title of ^{sl} slave
and that she is a slave for life, to
said Delling.

herein acknowledged, I have sold
to C. J. Delling one negro girl
named Sally aged about 16 years
which girl I warrant sound in
body and mind (with the exception
of one eye, which is out) and a
slave for life.
