CRL PROGRAMS

The Council on Library Resources will be offering the following three programs during the 1979-1980 academic year:

The Fellowship Program is open to mid-career librarians. The research projects will be designed to improve knowledge of essential matters affecting librarianship.

The Academic Library Management Intern Program is formulated to develop managers for large research and academic libraries. Each intern will work with the director and top level administrative staff of a large academic library. Applicants must have at least five years professional experience by September, 1979.

The Health Sciences Library Management Intern Program is intended to provide the same type of work experience as the academic library management program, and the requirements are similar.
