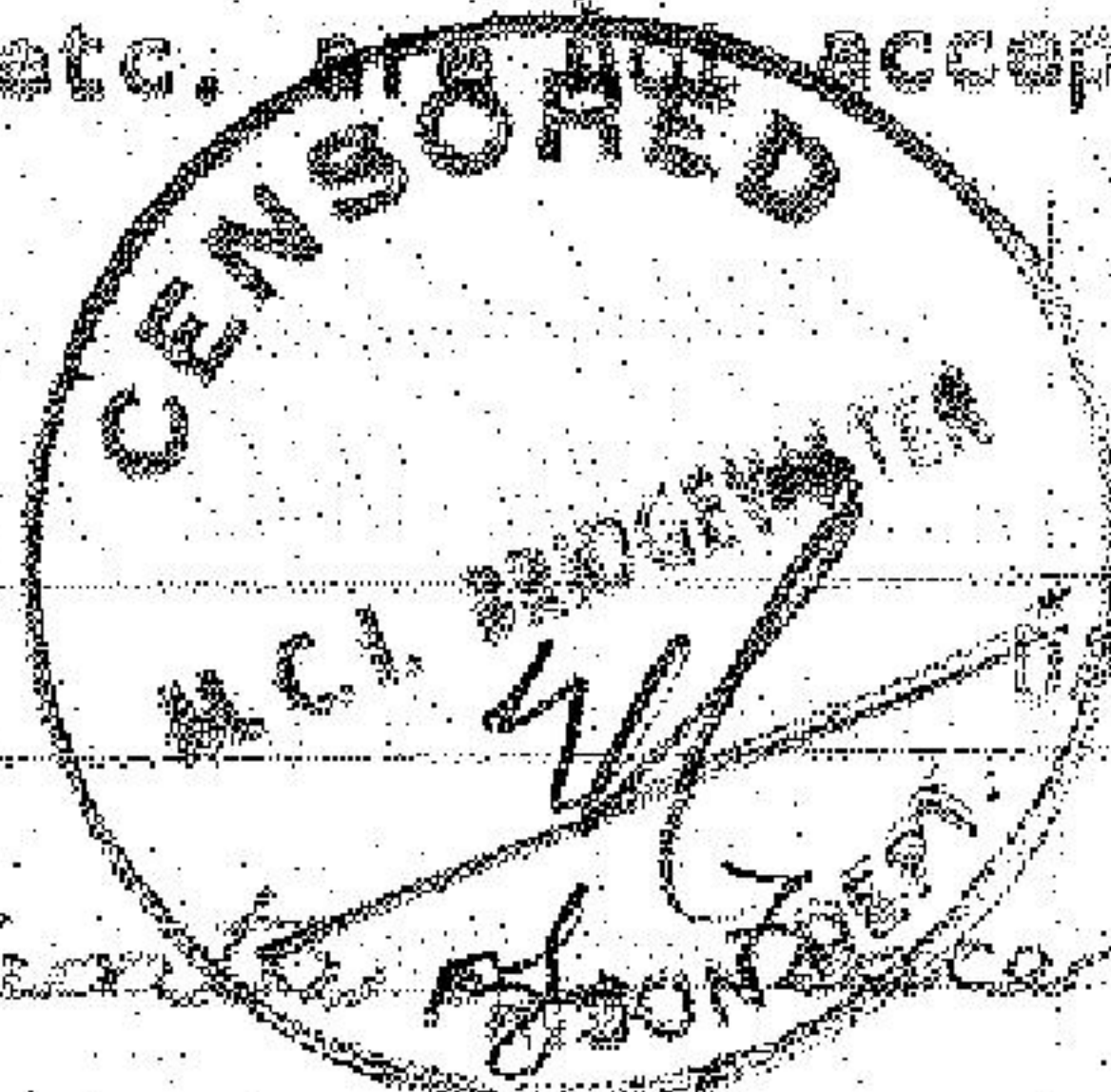


VISITING INMATES

Visiting of inmates will be permitted on weekdays from 9 to 11 A.M. and from 1 to 3 P.M. and on Sundays and Holidays from 1 to 3 P.M. Each inmate will be allowed a visit for not more than one hour beginning 5 days after his commitment and thereafter every 7 days. Two persons may be allowed a visit at the same time. Special visits may be granted by the Superintendent when the occasion requires it. No person known to be a user of drugs may receive a visit without the specific approval of the Superintendent. Do not send cash! Use money orders or checks.

No packages of any kind are to be received by inmates, except those permitted by the Superintendent. Books, magazines, periodicals, newspapers, etc. are not accepted unless sent directly by the publishers.
