

Inmates of this institution, of good deportment, of good deportment, may receive visits from relatives once each week only. Visitors allowed daily from 2 to 3 P.M. Sundays 2 to 4 P.M. Inmates writing to their friends, and persons corresponding with inmates must observe the following directions, viz: Write plain English and confine yourself strictly to family and business matters, do not underline, put but one line of writing on each ruled line. Fruit, except bananas, may be left at the office for the inmates but no other food will be allowed except on Holidays. All correspondence must go through the Master's hands.

Those awaiting trial may receive visits, also food as the keeper may direct.

Dear Bob: Received your letter today, concerning your latest manuscript, & reading of applications for research grant awards.
