Add-drop session to be Tuesday at coliseum

Add-drop is one of the more difficult processes students go through at the start of each semester.

Each year during the last week of August, students can be seen entering the doors of Memorial Coliseum, schedule books in hand, often cursing the ordeal.

Officials in the registrar's office say they realize Add-drop is a difficult process for students, but it's a process that most students end up going through at some point of their academic careers.

However, there are ways to make the process more bearable, said Margey McQuillin, former director of records for the office.

"Get your act together, organize

your thoughts and always add before you drop," she said.

McQuillin said one of the reasons students experience difficulty going through the Add-drop process is because they fail to prepare for it properly.

Before students enter the doors of the coliseum they should be familiar with the University bulletin and have an idea of what classes they want to take in mind," said Don Will, director of advising conferences.

McQuillin recommended that while students are standing in line to inquire about a class, they should keep alternative sections in mind. That way, if a desired section does not open, a student can request another section right away — without having to stand in line again.

Another way to acquire a desired section is to drop the class you want she said. She also suggested hanging around the table of a particular college while keeping your eyes open for someone dropping a class you want.

But in addition to keeping an open mind and an alert attitude, there are other things that students will need when going with them to Add-drop she said.

Students will be admitted into the coliseum alphabetically on Tuesday. Identification will be necessary in this process.

Students who are preregistered should bring their schedules with them, or duplicates will be e-mailed beginning Monday at 12:30 p.m. until Tuesday at 6. After that time,

they will be available in the registrar's office.

Add-drop will begin Tuesday for pre-registered students only. Admission to the coliseum will be handled alphabetically in 30-minute increments beginning at 10 a.m.

The alphabetical admission ends at 3:30, then all pre-registered students will be admitted until closing at 6.

Add-drop will continue through the first week of classes and end on the last day to add a class, Sept. 1.

No excuses will be accepted from students claiming to be able to attend Add-drop during its regular hours, McQuillin said.

Late registration can be done on Wednesday.

Summertime news

Campus didn't take summer vacation when most students left Lexington

While most students took a break from University life this summer, the news didn't.

Nor did this newspaper. During the hot summer months, The Kentucky Kernel continued to cover the UK campus as a weekly paper.

Perhaps the most important story was the coming of David Roselle. The new UK president began his tenure July 1, and proceeded to change some of the players while implementing his game plan for the University's future.

But the Kernel's pages were filled with more than Roselle taking office. The University acquired liability insurance for its employees, Radio Free Lexington was granted a federal license and the UK Medical Center received a \$1.7 million grant.

Here is a midsummer round-up of the summa-top stories to help you abreast of the news:

• Room and board rates were raised by about 4.2 percent beginning this semester to cover a salary increase for workers at Dining and Housing Services.

Dorm residents on a daily meal plan will be affected, paying an average of \$85 more. The cost of living in University housing will increase by about \$50.

Radio Free Lexington received a license from the Federal Communications Commission to operate on the 88.1 FM frequency. WRFL will have an effective broadcasting radius of six miles.

Also, the Student Activities Board allocated RFL space in the Student Center for construction of two studios and office space for production, information and training departments.

However, the UK Physical Plant Division estimated that RFL would need to spend \$20,000 to renovate the room, an expense that was at least \$8,000 more than RFL representatives said they initially expected.

• The Maxwell H. Gluck Equine Research Center was dedicated after four years of fund raising and construction. James Roselli, chairman of the veterinary science department and an internationally recognized expert in equine disease research, will serve as the center's director.

The Center for Robotics and Manufacturing Systems will be located behind McVey Hall, the center, which is scheduled to open in June 1988, will concentrate on research.

• The Medical Center introduced a new sports medicine program scheduled to begin this fall. The program will provide evaluation, treatment

• The \$551.8 million budget passed by the Board of Trustees was a dis-

• Liability insurance was bought for 11,000 UK faculty and staff, who have been nearly 1½ years without coverage. One-year errors and omissions insurance will cost \$178,105.

Coupled with the \$195,000 being spent for about 60 UK administrators and trustees, the total is substantial. The new liability insurance will cost about \$150 per year paid for coverage for both groups until February 1988.

SGA to have survey on RFL, dead days

In September, about 400 UK students will have the opportunity to voice an opinion on two of the more volatile student issues on campus.

Students will be asked if they would favor funding Radio Free Lexington with a \$2 increase in yearly activities fees.

In October, they will be asked if they would favor establishing two dead days before finals week each semester.

The phone survey, sponsored by the Student Government Association, will be conducted in early September by UK's Survey Research Center.

The survey will have a margin of error of plus or minus 5 percentage points, said Timothy Johnson, research coordinator for the survey research center.

Two dead days before finals would give students time to prepare for finals without having to attend regular classes. A \$2 increase in activities fees would give RFL the campus radio station, about \$30,000 in operating expenses each year.

Students now have one weekend between semesters.

Student input was wanted on the dead days issue before the Senate Council made any final decisions, according to SGA President Cyndi Weaver. The council, which is composed of faculty and student representatives, would decide whether to create the dead days.

Results from the survey will go to the Senate Council's calendar committee, which will conduct a feasibility study on the dead days, Weaver said.

Response to the issue has been less than unanimous. During last year's SGA officer elections, some candidates complained that dead days would interfere with sorority rush and disrupt an already established University calendar.

SGA members who took both sides of the issue are working on the planning of the question for the survey, Weaver said.

Funding from a fee increase could possibly be used next semester, said Kakie Urch, secretary/treasurer for the RFL board of directors.

The group has been trying for nearly two years to secure funding for a campus radio station. RFL

members had been pointing toward an Oct. 1 air date, but estimates on the renovation of a storage area at the station site exceeded available funds.

Scott Ferguson, general manager of RFL, approached Weaver this summer about the possibility of raising activities fees.

Full-time students currently pay \$38.75 in activities fees each semester. Activities fees, among other things, pay for student tickets to home football and basketball games and help fund SGA and the Student Activities Board.

Weaver said she wanted students to have the opportunity for input on the radio issue as well. A student referendum was considered, but Weaver said a survey is more appropriate because all sectors of campus are polled.

In response, she said, is generally a biased representation of student opinion because usually the only ones that vote are those strongly in favor or strongly against an issue.

The survey question about RFL funding will also contain a brief description of the types of programming the station would play, Weaver said.

A fee increase would ensure the existence of the station, though it would continue to raise funds throughout the year, Urch said. The funds "would facilitate getting us on the air and show the community . . . what college radio's all about."

There is a favorable response to the survey; once hearings will be held by the radio station for more student input, Weaver said.

Campus parking lots patrolled starting today

The UK parking department will be enforcing parking restrictions on "A" and "B" lots beginning today.

Students who park their cars in these lots will receive a ticket and have their car towed.

"A" and "B" stickers are restricted to faculty and staff of the University.

"A" and "B" lots are patrolled Monday through Friday from 5 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., said Betty Wade, manager of the department. Administration Drive is patrolled Monday through Thursday from 5 a.m. until 7:30 p.m.

Now is also the time for students eligible for "C" parking stickers to begin obtaining them.

"C" permits are limited to commuter students who are juniors, seniors and grad students.

Students can pick up a number tomorrow at the Student Center Ballroom, Wade said. These students can come back Wednesday through Friday to get their permit.

"At that time we will check them for classification," Wade said. "Just picking up a number doesn't ensure the fact that they will get a permit." She said exceptions will be handled on a one-on-one basis.
