ABOUT THE LIBRARIES

British Calendar Rolls Purchased:

King Library has recently purchased two reprint sets of primary source material invaluable to scholars doing original research in the field of British history. First is the Calendar of Patent Rolls issued between the reigns of Henry III (1216-1272) and Elizabeth I (1558-1603). The patent rolls announced royal acts of the most diverse kind including grants and leases of land appointments to offices, licenses and pardons, and presentations to ecclesiastical benefices. Second is the Calendar of Close Rolls issued between the reigns of Henry III and Henry VII (1485-1509). The close rolls contain a wide variety of royal instructions including the observance of treaties, the levying of subsidies, the delivery of landed inheritances, and the assignment of dower to widows. The two sets of calendars comprise over one hundred volumes and represent a notable improvement in the library's history holdings.
