New Indexes in Newspapers/Microtexts

N/M 791.457 C7235C The CBS News Index (v.1, 1975- , quarterly with an annual cumulation) indexes the morning, midday, and evening daily news broadcasts including CBS specials, special reports, and 60 Minutes. The index combines subject headings and personal names within one alphabetical list, and provides titles and identifiers for major government officials. Cross references and "see alsos" are indicated.

Each entry consists of a subject heading, a descriptive phrase about the broadcast content, and a locator which guides the user to the verbatim CBS news transcript. Entries also designate whether the story is reported by a correspondent or by an anchorman.

N/M has all the broadcasts on microfiche, beginning with 1975.

N/M 016.071 In238 The <u>Index to Black Newspapers</u> (1977- , quarterly) indexes 12 national papers of which we receive five. A subject index and personal name index provide access to news articles, editorials, entertainment reviews, and obituaries.

N/M 016.0711 C1604 The Canadian Newspaper Index (v.1, 1977- , monthly with an annual cumulation) indexes five newspapers of which we receive one, the Globe and Mail (Toronto). With separate subject and biographical indexes, coverage includes feature stories, editorials, news articles, and book and entertainment reviews.

On order but not yet received are the <u>Times of India Index</u>, the <u>Index to Barron's</u>, and the <u>Wall St. Journal Index</u>, 1955-1957.
