The faculty met in adjourned session in the President's room at 3pm.  
All present except Professor Neville and Captain Swigert.

Grade a pre-requisite for participation in Athletics

Attention was called to the fact that the heads of departments and other members of the faculty should carefully observe that regulation which requires that a certain class standing be maintained by students as a condition necessary to their eligibility to take part in athletic contests.

Professor Kastle's report of March 1<sup>st</sup> was then taken up and <sup>the recommendations thereof</sup> modified to read as follows:

1<sup>st</sup> That the first term close with the beginning of the Christmas holidays.

2<sup>nd</sup> That the Collegiate year be divided into three terms.

3<sup>rd</sup> That a few days be set apart at the close of each term for final examinations.

4<sup>th</sup> That students making a record of 14 or better on the daily work of the term may each or all at the discretion of the head of the department be thereby exempted from final examinations.

The recommendations as modified were approved

on motion ordered that the foregoing recommendations shall not apply to the Academy.



A motion ordered that the Board of Trustees be requested to so modify the regulations as to make examination grades count half of the yearly grade.
