

## Administrator says add/drop easy to do if students prepared

The lines will form tomorrow at Memorial Coliseum and the patience will wear thin, but with a little cooperation, everyone should survive centralized add/drop.

The process can be relatively painless if students are prepared and informed, George Dexter, associate registrar, said.

"Students need to bring a pencil, a copy of their original schedule and a schedule book if you have it," he said. Students also should bring the add/drop edition of the *Kentucky Kernel* to check available classes.

Students who add new courses need to drop others which are scheduled unnecessarily, Dexter said. "People don't realize there are students waiting to get in."

Some students wait until later in the semester to drop unwanted courses, making it impossible for other students to add the course, he said.

Student identification cards are not required but may speed up the processing at station one, located at the coliseum's entrance, he said.

"Students will check in and we'll give them a permit card to make sure that the student is here at the right time."

"Also at station one we have a set of instructions and a locator map," he said. "If students will take a minute or two to read the map they'll get everything processed quickly."

Dexter said the next station is a writing table where students can check for available classes and fill out add/drop slips which should have been obtained from their college dean's office.

"If a student hasn't been to their dean's office, we will have additional add/drop slips at station one."

Departmental tables are on the concourses. "Students will show the worker their permit card and are told if the classes are open or closed," he said.

The workers will give the student a computerized add or drop card for the course which must be completed in pencil. The last step is to turn the computer cards and a copy of the add/drop slip in at their dean's table, also located in the coliseum.

"A computerized add/drop card is required for each transaction," he said. "The add/drop slip can list all changes, but a separate computerized card is required for every transaction."

Dexter also said students changing their grading option, from pass/fail to credit or vice-versa, must fill out computerized cards.

Students changing credit hours on a course, either increasing or decreasing, also need to fill out a card.

"If students are dropping or adding (and their status full- or part-time) changes, they must have their fees reassessed," Dexter said. The Registrar's staff will be located in 107 Gillis Building through Jan. 24 to reassess fees.

## Financial aid may not 'absorb' education's cost

The Office of Student Financial Aid has good news and bad news for students this semester.

The good news is more money may be available for 1984, according to David Stockham, director of financial aid. "We expect there'll be some increases in federal funds — at least I, what we've asked for from Uncle Sam," he said.

The bad news is the increases probably will not make much difference. "As the cost of education goes up, the need of each student goes up," Stockham said. "In all likelihood, any aid funds will not be able to absorb all the increase in the

costs. Students will still be falling behind a little bit."

"Falling behind" is the standard course for most financial aid recipients, he said. "The problem is that there are only so many dollars to give out, and when they're gone, they're gone," he said. "Because there is not enough money to go around, we short all students relative to their need."

The Financial Aid Office has a hard time determining which students have the greatest need, he said. That decision is based on information students supply when they fill out the Kentucky financial aid form. All students must fill out the five-page form that comes with 10 pages of instructions, he said.

"The form is long and complicated but it's just something that has to be done," he said. "You have to discipline yourself to cross your 'i's and dot your 't's and fill in all that detail."

After the forms are turned into the Financial Aid Office, they are sent to College Scholarship Service, where they are analyzed and the need of each applicant is determined, Stockham said.

"It's important to note that our first analysis is done on an objective basis by an external service," he said. "We don't just arbitrarily decide these things."

After the analyses are returned from the service, the Financial Aid Office staff creates a "financial aid package" for the student, Stockham said. "Believe it or not, each one is done individually," he said.

The staff usually draws on a variety of sources to make up the package, he said — loans, grants and scholarships. But students must submit their financial aid request forms early in order to get the best possible combination.

"Apply early" he said. "There are some kinds of aid that run out." The deadline for application is June 30, but he urged students to get their applications in by April 15.

"Up to April 15, we let our applications pile up and we let our resources pile up," he said.

He also urged more students to apply for financial aid. "We're making work for ourselves, but we encourage students to apply."

## Drop class by Jan. 17, dean advises

Drop that course as "quickly as possible," John Christopher, associate dean for the College of Arts & Sciences, says.

Christopher explained that the last day to add a class is Jan. 17. The last day to drop a class, however, without a grade appearing on a student's transcript is Jan. 31.

If students procrastinate and fail to drop a class until after Jan. 17, those wanting to add the course will be out of luck.

Christopher estimated in an earlier interview that about 1,300 students drop English, French, history, math, philosophy and psychology courses at the "100" and "200" levels. "If students are going to drop a course and they know it, they should do it as quickly as possible because they're taking up valuable space," he said.

Courses are usually filled according to a student's cumulative grade point average, George Dexter, associate registrar, said. Each college, however, has its own standards for filling a course, according to the guidelines in the *Student Rights and Responsibilities* booklet.

Because Christopher is in charge of filling class within A&S, he is all too familiar with the high demand for certain classes and time periods each semester. He said courses in

areas such as psychology, computer science and biology usually close quickly. Classes scheduled for 9, 10 and 11 a.m., Monday-Wednesday-Friday periods and 9:30 and 11 a.m., Tuesday-Thursday periods also tend to fill quickly.

Also many courses in A&S have a size limitation imposed on them to facilitate teaching, Christopher said. English composition courses have no more than 25 students and some math classes have a 35 student ceiling. "And it's because of the style of teaching," he said. "Others (like chemistry and history courses) lend themselves to a lecture format."

Christopher also said availability of a classroom may determine when a course is scheduled and thus student demand for it. "The classroom situation is rather critical," he said. "At some hours every classroom around the University is scheduled." Room selection is dictated by the capacity level of the course, he said.

The College of Business & Economics also has a problem with

over-requested courses, said Regina Gibson, staff assistant to the associate dean for academic affairs in B&E. She said upper division courses usually have a waiting list because they are required for B&E degrees and also required by some other colleges.

Gibson said priority is given to B&E seniors, other students who need the course to fulfill a requirement and those who have met college prerequisite requirements.

"We haven't gotten all the bumps knocked out of it yet," Gibson said of the semesterly problem of over-requested classes.

Christopher said his goal is to make courses accessible to students. "We go out of our way to protect and meet student demand in core courses that are required for majors and general studies (courses)," he said.

Christopher, also a member of the University Senate, had proposed last semester a plan to make the last day to drop a class the eighth day of the semester. "I think many times students decide early to drop, but aren't encouraged to," he said in an earlier interview. The proposal, however, was defeated last October 4-2.

Following the defeat of the proposal, he said, "I will try in the future, and have in the past, to encourage students to drop classes as soon as possible."

## Opera, derby and talks slated to entertain campus

## 'Favorite Books'

### Course stresses pleasure of reading

Anthony Eardley, dean of the College of Architecture, would say *The Wind in the Willows*. James Rodgers, theater department chairman, however, would disagree, favoring *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest*.

The two professors have their favorite books. And this semester both Eardley and Rodgers, along with five others, will teach a course titled "Among My Favorite Books."

"The course is an effort to do something slightly different with a mini-course program," said Raymond Betts, director of the University Honors Program, which is sponsoring the one-credit class. "I thought it would be enjoyable, perhaps even inspirational, if students participated in a course that would stress the pleasure of reading."

The course, open to students with a junior standing and the instructor's approval, still has spots available and will meet 2 to 4 p.m.

Wednesdays in M.I. King Library.

Students enrolled in the course will discuss a book with the person who made the selection and write an review.

The books range the literary spectrum, including a discussion by President Onis A. Singletary on his proposed book concerning UK's history during his tenure here.

"I urged each to select a book he or she thoroughly enjoyed regardless of the book's literary stature," Betts said. "I sternly discouraged anything attributed to Homer, Shakespeare or Milton."

Participants include Susan Belmore, a professor of psychology; Carolyn Bratt, professor of law; Daniel Rowland, a professor of history; and Daniel Reedy, associate dean for the Graduate School.

"Each person I involved expressed delight and amusement," Betts said. "Its real virtue is it serves no particular academic purpose. Its value is to the individual participating in it for the pleasure of it."

The Central Kentucky Concert and Lecture series will present Jan. 19, Robert Hughes, art critic for *Time* magazine to lecture in The Center for the Arts Concert Hall on Jan. 19.

Other lectures scheduled for the Spring semester include:

- Feb. 9: Col. John Cottell lecturing on the "Anatomy of a Spy."
- Feb. 21: A performance by pianist Thomas Lorango.
- March 6: Roger Wagner Chorale.

The University Artists Series will

continue this Spring first presenting The Israel Chamber Orchestra on Feb. 15.

Additional programs include The Fine Arts String Quartet which will perform in October. On April 16, the series will conclude with a performance by Garrick Ohlsson.

The Lexington Philharmonic will continue its free performances at the Center for the Arts Concert Hall. Spring performances will be Jan. 13, Feb. 3, March 16 and April 13. All performances start at 8 p.m.

### SPRING SEMESTER STUDENT FINANCIAL AID REMINDERS

- \*Students who expect to receive financial aid must bring enough money to pay initial expenses such as books, meals, off-campus rent, and incidentals for at least the first three weeks of the semester.
- \*The release of financial aid is based on enrollment. Financial Aid recipients who use Add/Drop or who register in January must bring proof of registration (a signed schedule card, or a temporary full-time I.D. or permanent validated I.D.) to the 5th floor of the Office Tower. Late registration of Add/Drop will delay financial aid disbursement approximately two weeks.
- \*Financial aid recipients who lose their advanced registration for failure to pay their advanced \$50.00 payment for the spring semester by the December 21 deadline, will have to late register and confirm their enrollment as specified in the preceding item before any financial aid can be released.
- \*Full-time undergraduate and graduate students must successfully complete 24 and 18 credit hours respectively, between the fall semesters of 1983 and 1984, to remain eligible to receive financial aid for the following year.
- \*NATIONAL DIRECT STUDENT LOAN borrowers must attend a repayment meeting and sign a promissory note in the Worsham Theater before funds will be released. Meetings are scheduled at 9:00 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on January 9, 10, 12 and 13 at 9:30 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. on January 11.
- \*NURSING AND HEALTH PROFESSIONS borrowers are to attend a repayment session at 10:30 a.m. on January 11.
- \*All financial aid is disbursed from the Student Center, not the Student Financial Aid Office.
- \*Pell Grants are released only after students return their Student Aid Report (three green forms) to the Student Financial Aid Office. Pell Grants are credited to student accounts within a week to ten days after Student Aid Reports are received.

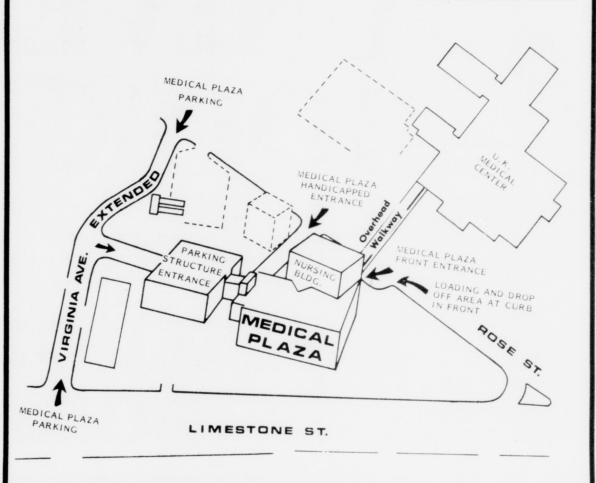
