to go on run.

Engineers and shovel wielders
at Evansville declare personal
safety endangered.

Owensboro, Ky., Aug. 11. — The Evansville

Courier this morning says:
Engineers and firemen on the St. Louis
and Henderson divisions of the L. & N.
railroad refused to take their
runs this morning, declaring that
their personal safety was endangered.
At 2:30 o'clock this morning the
caller had secured no men to
take their places. The Chairman
of the locomotive engineers and of the
firemen's brotherhoods would make
no statement to the public this
morning, saying that there was
nothing to give out.
