From Texas

By the Columbia, we have Texas papers to the 23^d inst.

They are going to publish the Galvestonian newspaper daily at Galveston.

A Mr. Lewis was killed on the Island the 18th inst. by a Mr. Brown, with a huge Bowie knife.

The dispute between the Texas and United States Line Commissioners, is confined to the proper point of departure. Our people contend for the embouchure of Lake Sabine into the Gulf, while the Texan people are for the mouth of the Sabine river, where it empties into the Lake. The matter has been referred to the governments of the respective republics, and the Commissioners will meet again on the 15th of April to run the line from the mouth of the river.

The steamer Brighton, plying between Galveston and Houston, has been snagged in Buffalo Bayou, and is sunk in deep water.

The steamer Correo has just
