
## Fire Island

Throughout the year the park presents different faces at different seasons. In winter the beach is deserted and the ocean booms as it assaults the land. The forests are stark as the leafless trees stand bare against their evergreen neighbors and the sky full of clouds. Springtime brings a greening to the land and a muting of the ocean, while the noise of new life quickens in the marshes. Rafts of migrating waterfowl bob on the protected waters of Great South Bay. Summer is the hot, golden sun on the white sands of the beach and the schillarated laughter and voices of people being refreshed by the cool water. Fall sees the birds return on their way south as quiet once again invades the island. The small animals prepare for winter, and summertime residents close up their houses.





























Access by car to Fire Island National Seashore is limited to the eastern and western ends of the park. Fees are charged for parking in Robert Moses State Park (westend) and in Smith Point County Park (east end).
