

Add-drop to kick off fall semester tomorrow

Arrive at scheduled time, consider the consequences, be ready to wait, administrator says

So your schedule didn't come out quite the way you wanted. You decided you didn't want to wake up at 7:30 in the morning for class, or your afternoon history class conflicts with your favorite soap opera.

Fear not, add-drop is here to remedy the situation. Well, sort of.

Add-drop begins at 10 a.m. tomorrow in Memorial Coliseum.

For best service students need to arrive at add-drop at the time listed on the add-drop schedule, which is arranged by students' last names. Students also need to bring a No. 2 pencil to fill out the add-drop cards. University Registrar Randall Dahl said it was "pointless to go early" to

the sessions because students will not be allowed in prior to their scheduling time.

Dahl said most students should have no problem with add-drop. He added that it "should be no problem accommodating" the number of students trying to make schedule changes.

However, horror stories are often associated with add-drop. Those stories usually center around the long lines and long wait that students often encounter.

Some of that waiting, though, can be avoided if students are realistic about their schedules and what can be done with them.

Assistant Registrar Margaret McQuikkin said add-drop tends to get crowded and muddled with people for various reasons.

McQuikkin said many students view add-drop as an opportunity to see friends for the first time. Also, in many cases students don't realize that there is not much that can be done with their schedules.

For example, students just trying to change times or sections of a class will probably not have too much luck. This is especially true with history and math classes, McQuikkin said. Many students should "seriously look at (their) schedules and decide that they do not need to change it."

Dahl said students who participate in add-drop to reduce their amount of class hours will receive a refund if they drop from full-time to part-time status.

If students wait until the first week of class to reduce their class

load, then they will receive an 80 percent refund. Starting Oct. 20 the refund will be only 50 percent.

Other important dates students need to remember are: —Aug. 27 through Sept. 3 — Late registration for returning students who did not preregister. Also, new students who were cleared late for admission may register then.

—Sept. 3 — the last day to add a class.

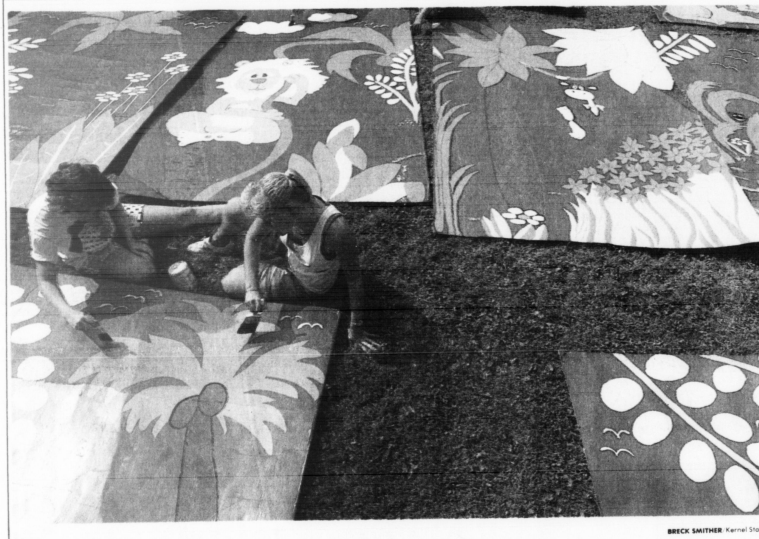
—Sept. 17 — the last day to change a grading option from receiving a letter grade to pass/fail. It is also the last day that students can drop a course without it appearing on their transcripts.

Park it

University parking department trades size for space as a solution to problems on campus

In the issue of campus parking spaces, the University giveth and it taketh away.

"We're going to gain some and we're going to lose a few," said Don Thornton, associate director for administration and transportation.

The University has added parking spaces and lots to compensate for those lost to construction on campus.

"I think the administration has done an excellent job in responding to the complaints that came last year," Thornton said.

Some complaints came in response to the 200 spaces lost in the "A" and "B" parking lot off Rose Street because of construction of the new faculty club and the mining and minerals building. Of that number, a few will be returned when the buildings are completed, Thornton said.

However, "all of the 'A' parking has been lost," he said.

Also, about 245 student and faculty parking spaces will be taken away during construction of an addition to

Shively Sports Center.

About 136 spots have already been taken away at the Seaton Center.

As one solution to the problem of campus parking, the University has exchanged comfort for accommodation.

Motorists may find themselves walking more and having less room to park.

In some lots, the widths of parking spaces have been decreased to accommodate more cars. This has added about 50 spaces to the commuter lot behind Memorial Coliseum and 17 spaces to the commuter lot behind the Taylor Education Building, Thornton said.

People aren't going to have the comfort of parking in 10-foot spaces," he said, but more spaces will be available.

Thornton said workers have traditionally painted over existing lines although cars have decreased in size. About half of the vehicles on campus are compact cars, he said.

Also, Thornton said the lots primarily provide long-term parking, with motorists leaving their cars on

campus for about four to eight hours.

"The rule is with long-term parking, you don't need as much space," he said. As long as people park properly, there should be ample room in the space.

Decreasing the width of the parking space "allows you to accommodate more of the students, which is what we're trying to do," he said.

In addition to decreasing the size of the spaces, the University is increasing the size of some of the lots. A gravel "B" lot, adjacent to the small fraternity row lot off Hilltop Avenue, has been enlarged from its 80-car capacity.

A "B" lot has been made between Columbia and Clifton avenues and work should be completed around October or three additional levels at the four-level parking structure on Virginia Avenue, adjacent to the Medical Plaza. The new levels should add about 450 spaces for faculty and staff parking, Thornton said.

A "B" and commuter lot near Sports Center Drive is now open to

accommodate about 200 vehicles. "B" lots are also open to people with "A" permits.

The parking problems, however, have not made the parking department any more lenient in ticketing cars.

Thornton said students are often misinformed about being able to park in faculty lots without being ticketed at the start of the year. "A" and "B" parking lots are currently being patrolled.

However, students can, for now at least, park in the commuter, resident and Commonwealth Stadium lots until permits are issued and the lots go on control.

Thornton recommends that students, especially those who live on campus and don't use their cars much, go ahead and park in the "K" lot at Commonwealth Stadium.

Resident and commuter permits are issued on a first-come, first-served basis.

"Everybody can be accommodated," said Betty Wade, parking department manager, "but not necessarily with the type of sticker they want."

Food Services offers new meal program

DinerCard account enables students to use 'checkbook' dining approach

This year the Food Services program will offer students an alternate approach to campus dining.

The UK DinerCard, which will supplement existing meal plans, will operate on a declining balance concept. "Basically, it works kind of like a checkbook," said Allen Rieman, director of Food Services.

Each time students make a purchase, the amount is deducted from the balance. Rieman said. Students can use their meal cards an unlimited number of times.

The minimum rate for the DinerCard will be \$450 per semester for students living in residence halls. The base price, which is similar to the two meals, five days a week rate, will allow students to spend about \$5.40 per day.

Students can add to their balance in \$50 increments, he said. In the fall semester, students can carry up to \$450 over to the spring semester. At the end of the spring semester, however, no carryovers or refunds of the base fee will be made.

Portions of the minimum balance cannot be refunded because the fee provides the basic amount needed to cover operating expenses, such as wages, debt service on the residence halls and utilities, Rieman said. "It's kind of like if you pay your tuition and don't go to class."

Students who add to their balance can receive a refund of the amount remaining at the end of the semester or upon withdrawal from the University for a \$5 handling charge.

Off-campus residents can participate in the DinerCard program by paying in \$50 increments. For a \$5 handling fee, they will receive a refund of the balance upon termination of their account.

Rieman expects the new meal plan to appeal to most students because it provides more freedom. "We feel this will be very advantageous to most students."

Students will have more control over what they pay for, he said. "Students can more or less dictate how they're going to spend 'their money.'"

The Food Services office first proposed implementing a declining balance program about 12 years ago, Rieman said. Students, however, voted the proposal down because it did away with the existing meal program in favor of the account system.

The meal program that will be available this year will allow students their choice of plans. They can participate in the new declining balance system or they can opt to continue using the traditional meal plan of a set number of meals for a set number of days.

Students in the DinerCard program can even partake of the unlimited servings available in cafeterias by purchasing a guest ticket.

Although the new program offers more flexibility, it also has the potential for problems: Students could run out of money before the semester ends.

But Rieman said the 25 percent of the student population who live in residence halls can learn to budget their money like students who live off campus.

"It's not like they're going to be told suddenly one day that all their money is gone," said Robert Braun, assistant director of Food Services. "If that happens, it won't be a surprise."

Students will be able to see their account balance each time they use their DinerCard, Braun said. They will be able to watch their balances go down gradually.
