The Faculty met at the usual hour.

The general conduct of Mr Laughinghouse was reduced 10% for ringing the large bell at Ashland at an improper time. The general conduct of Messrs Wayfield and Dodge was reduced 10% each for disorder in quarters. Messrs Bell and J. V. Adams were reduced in general conduct, 10% each for visiting during study hours.
