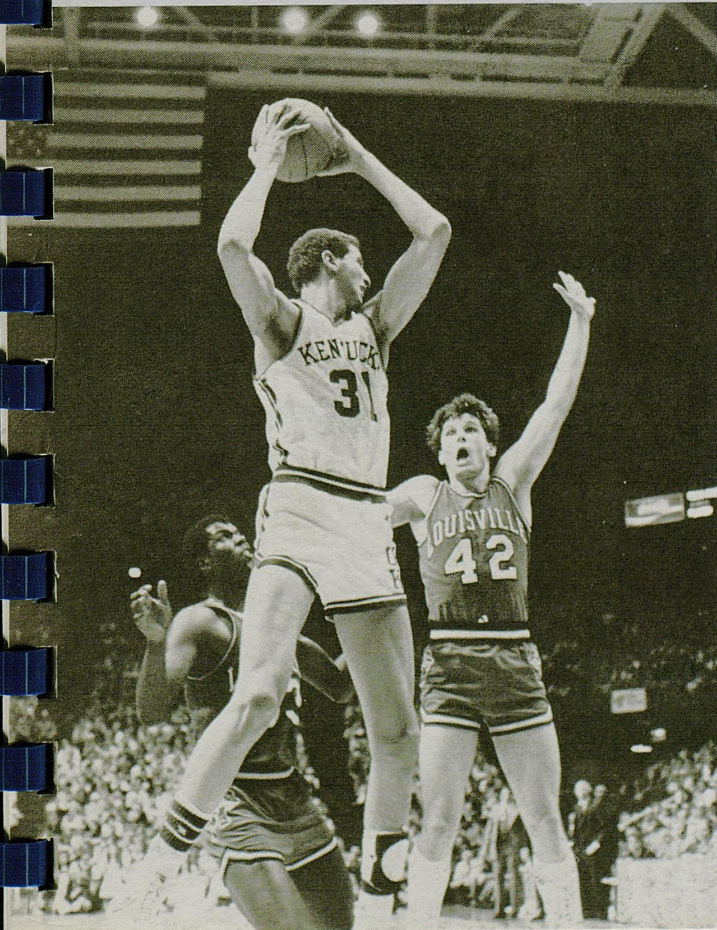
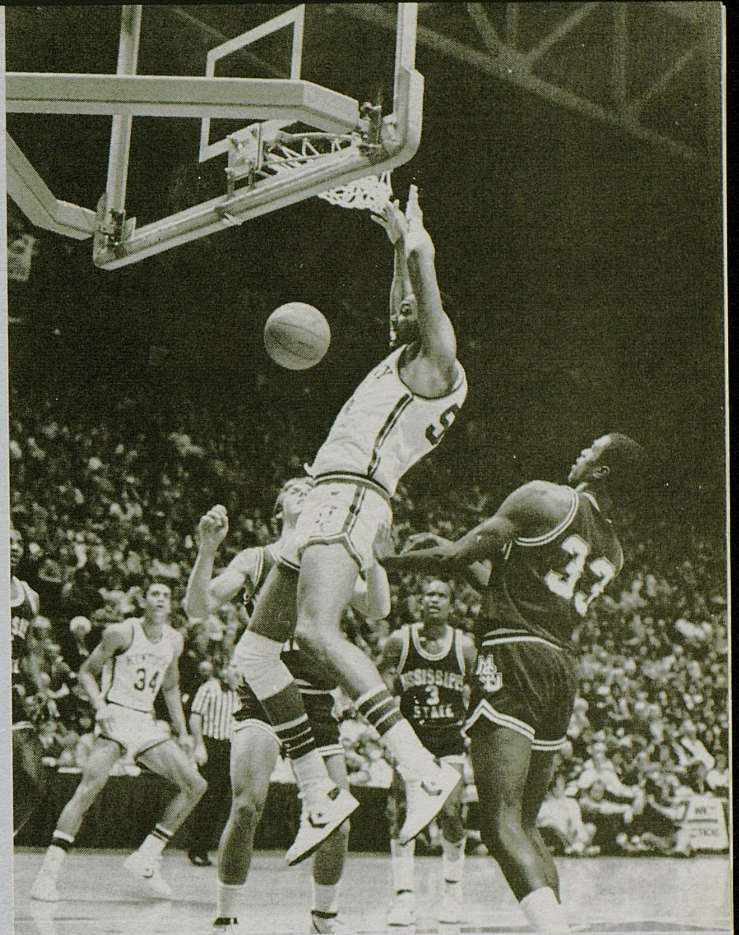

#### WILDCAT NOTES

Kentucky's 1983-84 Southeastern Conference championship is its 35th. Next in line among SEC schools is Tennessee with seven conference championships. It's SEC Tournament championship was its 13th.

# # #

Coach Joe B. Hall is in his 12th season at Kentucky and has a 277-86 (76.3%) record as coach of the Wildcats. He is in his 18th year as a head coach on the collegiate level and has a 353-142 (71.3%) career mark. His UK teams have won or shared eight SEC championships, won the NIT, finished as runners-up in the NCAA tournament (1975), and won the national championship (1978).

The Wildcats are 27-4 overall and finished 14-4 in the SEC. When ahead at halftime, UK has gone on to win 19 of 21 games (Nine wins at home, six wins on the road, three wins on neutral courts, and two losses on the road). When trailing at halftime, UK has won six of eight games (Five wins at home, one win on the road, and two losses on the road). The Wildcats have been tied twice at halftime, a road win at Mississippi and an SEC Tournament victory over Alabama.

Kentucky's all-time scoring list has undergone constant change this season. Melvin Turpin is now in 9th place on the list with 1,477 career points. Ralph Beard is 8th place with 1,517 points. Jim Master and Sam Bowie are tied for 19th place with 1,256 points. Jim Andrews is in 18th place with 1,320 points.

In UK's last 11 games, senior guard Dicky Beal has scored 107 points (9.7 ppg.) and handed out 80 assists. He has hit 38 of 63 shots from the field (60.3%) and 31 of 39 shots from the line (79.5%). He has started nine games in a row. His two free throws at the 0:03 mark enabled UK to defeat Alabama 48-46 in the semi-finals of the SEC Tournament. His 14 assists against Brigham Young in the NCAA Second Round tied the Kentucky school record.

# # #

Wildcat center Melvin Turpin is still ahead of the pace in his quest to become UK's all-time field goal shooter. His career mark is currently 59.6 percent. Charles Hurt set the mark last season at 59.3 percent. Turpin has led UK in scoring 13 times this season. He has scored in double figures in all but five games including the last 17 in a row. His top game came in the SEC Tournament against Georgia when he hit 18 of 22 from the field, six of seven from the line, pulled down 16 rebounds, and scored 42 points. He tied UK Director of Athletics Cliff Hagan's mark for points in an SEC Tournament game, and he broke Hagan's field goal mark (16) with his 18 two-pointers.



More Wildcat Notes

Sam Bowie's consistent progress this season is well indicated by the fact that he led UK in scoring the last three regular season games and in rebounding in seven of the eight regular season games. He has been the Wildcats' leading scorer five times and the team's leading rebounder 18 times. He has had 10 or more rebounds in eight of the last 14 games. Besides having scored more than 1,200 points in his career, Bowie has pulled down more than 800 career rebounds.

Sophomore forward Kenny Walker has scored in double figures in all but five games this season, including 17 of the last 18 games and 23 of the last 25 games. More than 55 percent of Walker's points this season have come in the second half of games. His jumper at the buzzer gave the Wildcats a 51-49 victory over Auburn in the SEC Tournament championship game.

The Wildcats won the University of Kentucky Invitational Tournament for the 23rd time in 31 tournaments this season.

Kentucky has played on national, regional, or local television in all 31 of its games this season.

Kentucky, the all-time winningest team in college basketball, now has an overall record of 1356-422-1.

# # #

Kentucky's five signees thus far this season are Ed Davender, a 6-2 guard from Brooklyn, N.Y.; Cedric Jenkins, a 6-9 forward from Dawson, Ga.; Robert Lock, a 6-11 center from Reedley, Calif.; Richard Madison, a 6-8 forward from Memphis, Tenn.; and Todd Ziegler, a 6-7 forward from Louisville, Ky.

Melvin Turpin has been named to every All-Southeastern Conference team. He was also named to the SEC all-tournament team. He was named to the second unit of the Basketball Writers' All-Merica team.

Kenny Walker rebounded from a 1-11 shooting night against Alabama in the semifinals of the SEC tournament to hit 6-7, including the game-winner, in the championship game against Auburn.

More Wildcat Notes

Sam Bowie has been named second team All-America by both the Associated press and the Sporting News.

All but four teams on the 1983-84 Kentucky schedule have appeared in postseason play (either the NCAA or NIT). Only Wyoming, Cincinnati, Mississippi, and Mississippi State did not appear. Ten Wildcat opponents were selected for the NCAA Tournament.

# # #

Kentucky and Louisville have met 13 times with the Wildcats winning on nine occasions. Louisville defeated UK in last season's Mideast Regional final, 80-68 in overtime. Kentucky defeated UL 65-44 earlier this season in Rupp Arena. Jim Master scored 19 points and Melvin Turpin added 16 to lead Kentucky. Freshman Mark McSwain came off the bench to score 10 points and was the only Cardinal in double figures.

# # #

Kentucky and Illinois have met 14 times with Kentucky winning on 10 occasions. The Wildcats defeated the Illini 56-54 earlier this season in Champaign. James Blackmon hit a last second shot for the Wildcats. Jim Master and Sam Bowie scored 11 points each for UK, while Doug Altenberger led Illinois with 19 points.

Kentucky has won four of seven meetings with Maryland. They last met on Dec. 15, 1958, with Kentucky winning 58-56 in overtime in Lexington.
