

Contract and agreement made and entered into this the 7th. day of April, 1922, by and between Lorman, Robinson Shows., Incorporated, party of the first part, and Wisconsin Steel Company, Incorporated, party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: For and in consideration of one dollar each to the other in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, this contract remains binding. Party of the first part agrees to give and conduct an amusement enterprise at Benham, Kentucky, for one week, more or less, commencing Monday - April 17, 1922, and to furnish for said event all high class paid moral attractions, for which admission is charged. No "49" shall be opened unless later agreed upon by both parties.

The party of the first part agrees and contracts to further pay the electric light power bill at the rate of and on the basis of thirty cents per forty watt lamp for all lamps used; ~~at~~ ^{at} five cents per kilowatt hour provided party of first part will furnish meter. The party of the first part agrees to furnish all lamps, wire and labor necessary for same. The party of the first part agrees and contracts further to make settlement with the Wisconsin Steel Company, Incorporated, for said electric power on Saturday, April 22, 1922.

Party of first part shall not be held liable for any damage arising under this contract in case of railroad accident or delay, or any other act of providence over which party of first part has no control that would prevent party of first part from fulfilling this engagement.
