Dear Sir:-

We enclose you herewith a list of the tenants of the Wisconsin Steel Co., for the year 1918, and we are sending to Mr. F. J. O'Connell a copy of this letter and a copy of the list and also the leases, as this seems to be the safest way to send them *you can get them from him.*

We have gone over these leases and filled in full the description. We hope that we have gotten them correct and believe we have, but would like to call your attention to the following changes:

We would call your attention to the fact that the last leases which we had printed for you have a corrected description of the present Wisconsin Steel Co., boundary after cutting out the Oliver lands. The old lease, of course, included the Oliver lands and we notice that for the 1918 leases you have used some of the old leases. While this is not very material, yet we would suggest that in the future you be careful to use only those leases which describe the Wisconsin Steel Co., property as being bounded on the South and West by Clover Lick Creek and not those leases which extend over to Fugates Creek.

In Lease No. 1 you will note that we have included in it the J. H. McKnight farm and all of the John Creech home farm not being used by the Company. This John Creech place should be included in this or some lease with this exception. If there is any one else who has the Creech home farm we have not found a lease for it.

Leases Nos. 2 and 2a: You will note that we have shown that J. J. Huff has those parts of the Joe M. Creech tract and the Caleb Huff tract which lie North of the Railroad, and that Alio Gants has that part of the Bill Ison part Joe M. Creech tract South of the Railroad. We presume that you refer in this lease to the John M. Creech tract as the Bill Ison farm, and if we are not correct in this, this lease should be corrected. We are going on the idea that J. J. Huff, Alio Gants, Harrison Blair and Sam Holcomb, all taken together, will have the whole of the Creech & Huff places.

Lease No. 5-Wm. Scott: You refer to this as being a lease of a part of the Enoch Blair and W. L. Creech lands. Does not Scott have the whole of these tracts? We have so described it in the lease, and if this is not correct it should be corrected.
