Re: J. L. Ferrell v Stonega Coke & Coal Company

When Mr. Sine was over to see you sometime ago regarding the above case he brought with him a copy of a telegram received from W. A. Tucker and copy of report of C. R. Petty; also a copy of the notice of employment. We appreciate this information very much, and I am herewith returning to you the three original papers, copy of which we have made for our file. At the time Mr. Sine was over there he tells me that you did not have complete records on the case, and that probably by this time you have found some more information. If you have I would greatly appreciate your sending it to me, or copies of whatever you may have.

We have talked to W. B. Ford, who was Ferrell's section foreman, and is now located at Linden, Virginia, but he states that he does not remember anything about this accident. Mr. Sine failed to get in touch with Amrus Jarves, Assistant Foreman to Ford, who is still located at Benham. If it would not be asking too much I should appreciate your talking to this man and finding out just what he knows about Ferrell's disability from June 1st to June 15th, 1925.

We appreciate this information very much, and if the occasion arises we wish to assure you that we shall be more than glad to reciprocate at any time.
