## Join the long, winding lines of centralized Add-Drop

Lines will begin forming in Memorial Coliseum today as new students who did not register in advance and those transferring from other universities register for classes, but the real chaos will probably begin tomorrow.

As always, many of the 17,987 students who pre-registered for the spring semester will enter Memorial Coliseum and endure long lines to rearrange class schedules, often to avoid early morning and late afternoon classes. Although many students were assigned the courses they asked for, the meeting times don't always fit the student's preferred schedule.

"We were able to honor 97 percent of the pre-registration requests, although in some cases class times had to be changed," said George Dexter, associate registrar for registration and advising.

The alternate scheduling procedure introduced in November's spring pre-registration probably won't diminish the number of add-drop participants. "The new alternate scheduling procedure probably will have little effect on the number of students going through add-drop this semester," Dexter said.

Under the new policy, students sign up for their preferred schedule as usual. Then, they fill out a second schedule card in addition to the first, listing their choice of a substitute course in case one class — which the

student must specify — is closed. Centralized add-drop for pre-registered students begins at 10 a.m. Students are scheduled at 30-minute intervals to line up in groups according to the first two letters of their last name.

UK students registering late can sign up for classes Wednesday and Thursday from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on the Patterson Office Tower mezzanine.

The 17,987 students who pre-registered for the spring semester is an increase of 800 over the figures for the 1979 spring semester, according to Dexter. Total enrollment figures for the spring semester will not be available until the Registrar's office determines how many of the students who register actually remain on campus.

After tomorrow's centralized add-drop in Memorial Coliseum, students can go to the offices of college deans to add and drop classes.

Here are a few suggestions on how to make the add-drop process a little easier. Before going to the Coliseum, students should:

Know which classes you are enrolled in according to your class schedule, or bring a copy of your schedule.

Bring a copy of the Spring Schedule of Classes.

Bring a No. 2 lead pencil.

Bring your UK ID card.

Don't try to go through add-drop before your scheduled time; there are strict procedures to follow. Students can come after their appointed time, however.

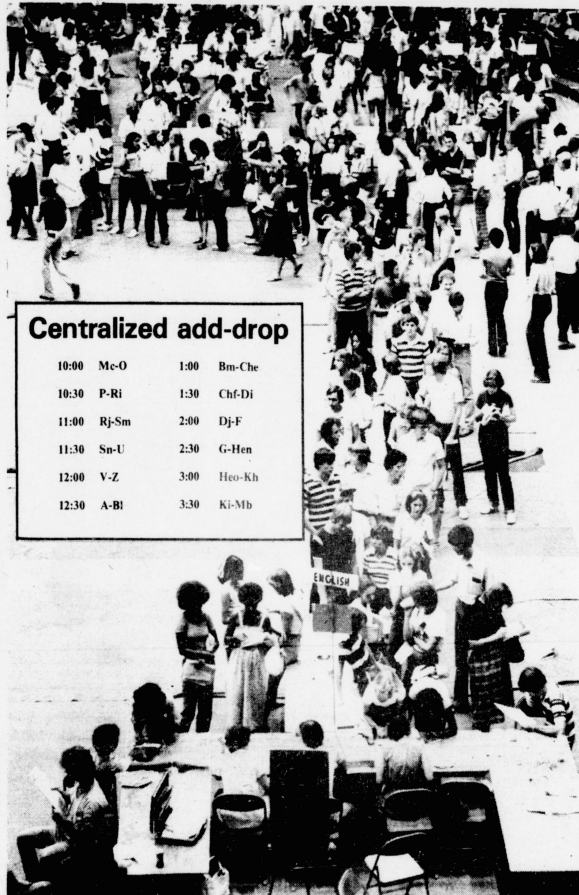
When going through the process, remember to pick up an IBM add-drop permit card, an instruction sheet and an add-drop slip. After deciding which classes to drop or add, pick up a computer card for each class at the department and college tables on the concourses or the Coliseum floor. Maps will be available to help students locate the various department tables.

Each transaction requires a computer card; to change sections students must collect two computer cards — one computer card to drop a section and another to add a section. However, only one add-drop slip is needed.

Besides adding or dropping courses, you may also change the number of hours you take in variable credit course. You may also change your grade option to letter grade, pass/fail or audit.

After filling out your add-drop slip and computer cards, return them to the dean's table of the college in which you are enrolled.

Oh, save those neat little add-drop slips. You might have to verify any transactions later.

During the rush to finish exams and hurry home for the holidays it's easy to misplace important items and say "I'll find it later." In the rush to return to campus and beat the traffic, it's easy to forget necessities such as your UK ID, fee payments and meal card.

Don't panic.

Tables will be set up in the Student Center Ballroom this week from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for students who need to pay fees for room and board, tuition, the

Student Health Service, validate or have new UK IDs made and Blue Cross Blue Shield Insurance.

The Kernel will resume its Monday through Friday (every class day) publication Jan. 16. Good luck with add-drop, fee payments and the coming semester.

## Refund deadlines

Withdraw from classes early to receive larger tuition refunds

Students who miss UK's three deadlines for withdrawing from classes or college will also miss their chance to collect refunds, which decrease in amounts as the semester progresses.

Requests for refunds must be processed on or before these dates — Jan. 15, the day before classes begin; Jan. 22, the last day to enter an organized class; and March 7, the last day to drop a course. "If you plan to meet the deadline for a refund, then you should initiate your schedule change in good time," said George Dexter, associate registrar for registration and advising.

The deadline to receive a full refund is Tuesday, Jan. 15. Students who paid their tuition fee but decided to withdraw from college must notify the registrar's office.

And, pre-registered students who reduce the number of part-time hours they are taking or who change their student status from full- to part-time are also eligible for a refund.

After decreasing their class hours, these students need their fees reassessed to receive a refund and should go to the Registrar's table in the Stu-

dent Center Ballroom. Bring identification and the add-drop slip to prove the transaction took place.

Even if students don't attend classes and withdraw later, the tuition refund drops to 80 percent after the Jan. 15 deadline.

"Jan. 22 will be the last day to withdraw from a class and receive an 80 percent refund; after that time, and up until March 7, students will be able to receive 50 percent refunds for fees paid on classes dropped," Dexter said. "After March 7, no refunds can be

recovered."

All refunds, full or partial, are made through the Registrar's Office, 107 Gillis Building (Administration Annex) after the first week.

Another important financial date is Jan. 29, the last day to pay registration fees (tuition). Students not paying by then will lose their student status. Students must pay a \$50 reinstatement fee plus the original tuition fee by Feb. 7 to regain their student status. Make tuition payments before 3:30 p.m. in the Billings and Collections office, 220 Service Building to avoid cancellation.

## Calendar of events

Important dates to remember for 1980 spring semester

**Jan. 14** — Registration for NEW students who did not advance register. Ballroom open for fee payment and ID picture-taking and validation. Students paying fees at this time will be those who did not pay by mail or are receiving financial aid through UK.

**Jan. 15** — Centralized add-drop for advance registered students only, in Memorial Coliseum, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. It is also the last day to withdraw from a class and be eligible for a full refund if status is changed from full-time to part-time, or if part-time hours are reduced.

**Jan. 16** — CLASSES BEGIN. Add-drop for the College of Arts & Sciences in Buell Armory; after today it moves to the dean's office. All other colleges' add-drop will take place in respective

deans' offices.

**Jan. 16-17** — Late registration for returning students who did not advance register AND for new students cleared late for admission. Report first to the Patterson Office Tower mezzanine, 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. A \$20 late fee is charged for late registration.

**Jan. 18** — Late registration continues in Advising Conference Office, 204 Miller Hall, 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**Jan. 22** — Last day to enter an organized class. Last day to withdraw or reduce part-time hours and receive an 80 percent tuition refund.

**Jan. 29** — Last day to pay registration fees (tuition) to avoid cancellation

of your registration. Pay in Billings and Collections Office, 220 Service Building by 3:30 p.m. Last day for new students to pick up ID cards from Photographic Services (basement of Kastle Hall) without paying \$5 replacement fee.

**Feb. 5** — Last day to change grading option (Pass/Fail to credit or credit to Pass/Fail; credit to audit or audit to credit; alter number of hours in variable credit hour courses). See your college dean. Last day to drop a course with no indication of course on transcript record.

**Feb. 7** — Last day for reinstatement of students cancelled for not paying registration fees. Must pay registration fee plus \$50 reinstatement fee. Last day to pay spring health fee.

**Feb. 14** — Last day to file for May degree in your college dean's office.

**March 7** — Last day to drop a course. Last day to withdraw from the University or reduce part-time schedule and receive 50 percent refund. Request refunds through Registrar's Office, 107 Gillis Building.

**March 17-21** — Spring break — no classes.

**April 14-23** — Advance Registration for 1980 Fall Semester and both 1980 Summer sessions (four-week and eight-week).

**May 5-9** — Final Examinations.

**May 10** — Commencement Exercises.
