

Savannah Ga. Dec. 27/64

Dear brother Hiram:

A week ago last Sunday I wrote a letter to father and mother before Savannah was in our hands. now the place is in possession of our troops and our camp is within the city limits and having an opportunity I will try to write a few lines to you.

We are now enjoying a rest of which this is the 4th day, after marching and working 37 days without a whole days rest. but now we are at the end of our present campaign. but how long it will be before we start on another march. time will tell it is the general impression that the army will not remain here a great while.

and as quick as we can get some new clothes we shall be ready if necessary to take a trip through S. Carolina, to let her
