

Washington D. C. May 25/65

Dear brother Hiram

I will again write a few lines to you, as I am not mustered out yet, and may not be until my time is served out.

We are now encamped some 4 or 5 miles from Washington, above Geo. town.

Yesterday we passed in review, the day before the army of the Potomac was reviewed, you will get the details and description of the occasion better than I can do it, yet I will say that it was the most splendid spectacle I ever witnessed, early in the morning we crossed the river in advance of the 14th corp, the 15th gen. Sagar, preceded us, at 9 o'clock the column began to pass in review, close column, by company front, our reg. platoon front on account of the corp. being so large.
