1. Cadet Slay. Charge: Absent without leave, breaking arrest, firing ball cartridge in College Grounds.
2. Cadets Burbridge, Emery and Logan. Charge: Firing Ball Cartridge in College Grounds, March 6th.
 Moved and seconded (Prof Shackleford) that they be dismissed. Amended (Dr Peter) that they be suspended to the end of the term + 2nd Amend^t. (Prof White) that they be put under arrest for 2 months. Sec. 2nd Amend^t moved lost. Gives amendment carried, original motion lost.
3. Cadet Logan: charge: Failing to take up his proper number of studies and general neglect of study. Moved and seconded that his father be requested to withdraw him. Carried.
4. Cadet Bugale. Charge: (Draught, firing pistols etc.) Moved and seconded that he be publicly dismissed. Carried. There being no further business the Faculty adjourned.
